Busy hands wave hello!





BABYBUG is for babies who love to be read to—and for adults who love to read to them. Here are a few tips to help you get the most out of this "come visit me" issue of BABYBUG.

- **1. Kim and Carrots:** As an adult, you know the value of a little privacy. Children need it, too, especially during the holidays when family gatherings, giftgiving, and parties are crammed into a few hectic weeks. With a blanket and chairs, your child can find a retreat as peaceful as Kim's.
- **2. Grandma's Coming:** An early step in understanding colors lies in matching them. Find several toy cars of the same colors as those in this poem. Play a game of parking them on matching cars in the illustration. Then keep the fun going by parking them on nearby objects of the same color.
- **3. Busy Hands:** The simple gestures shown here are among the earliest children imitate. Your baby will reach toward objects with a fist before pointing an index finger like Daddy. And before learning to wave hello or goodbye, babies often curve their fingers inward and cheerfully wave to themselves.
