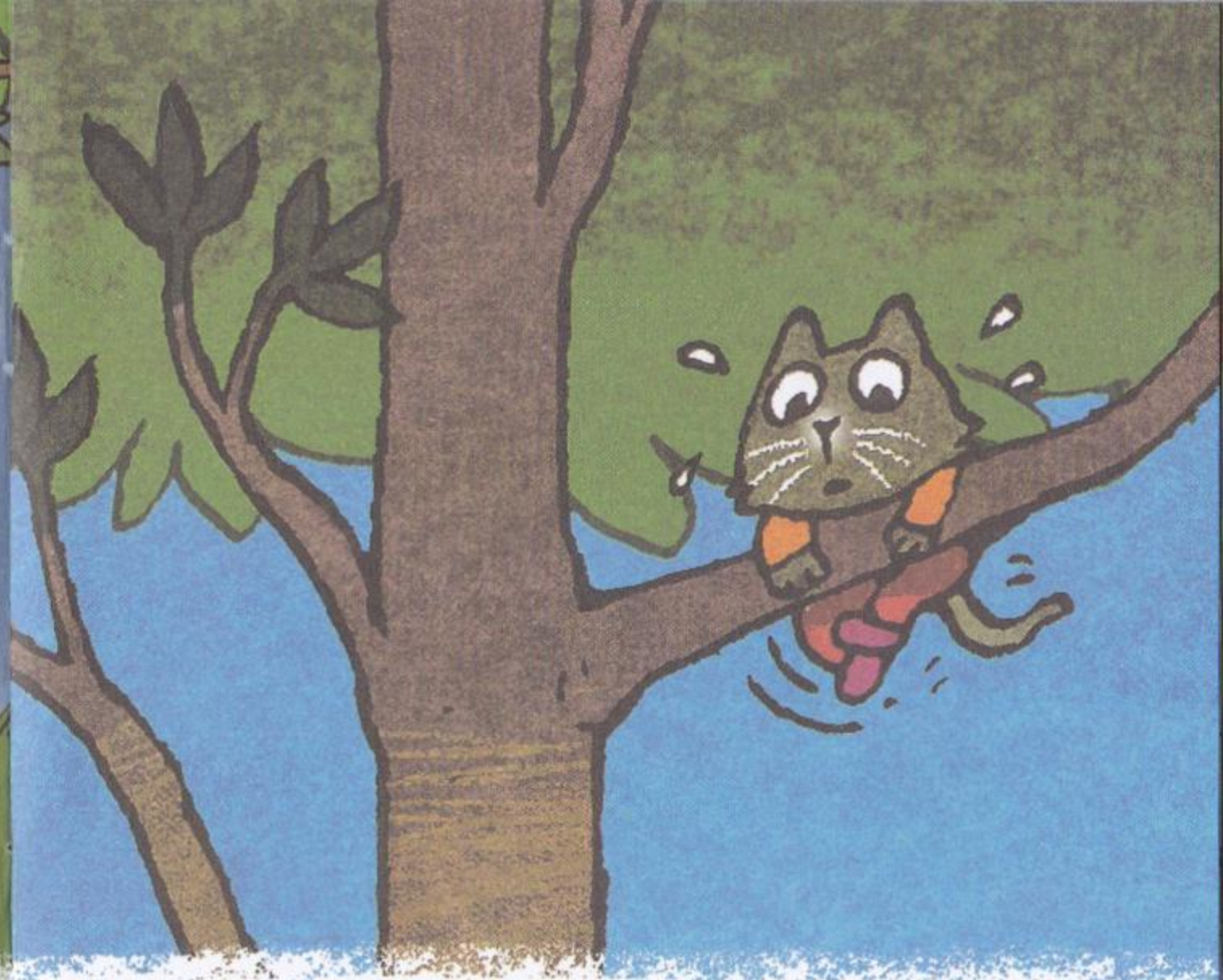


Nat likes to climb

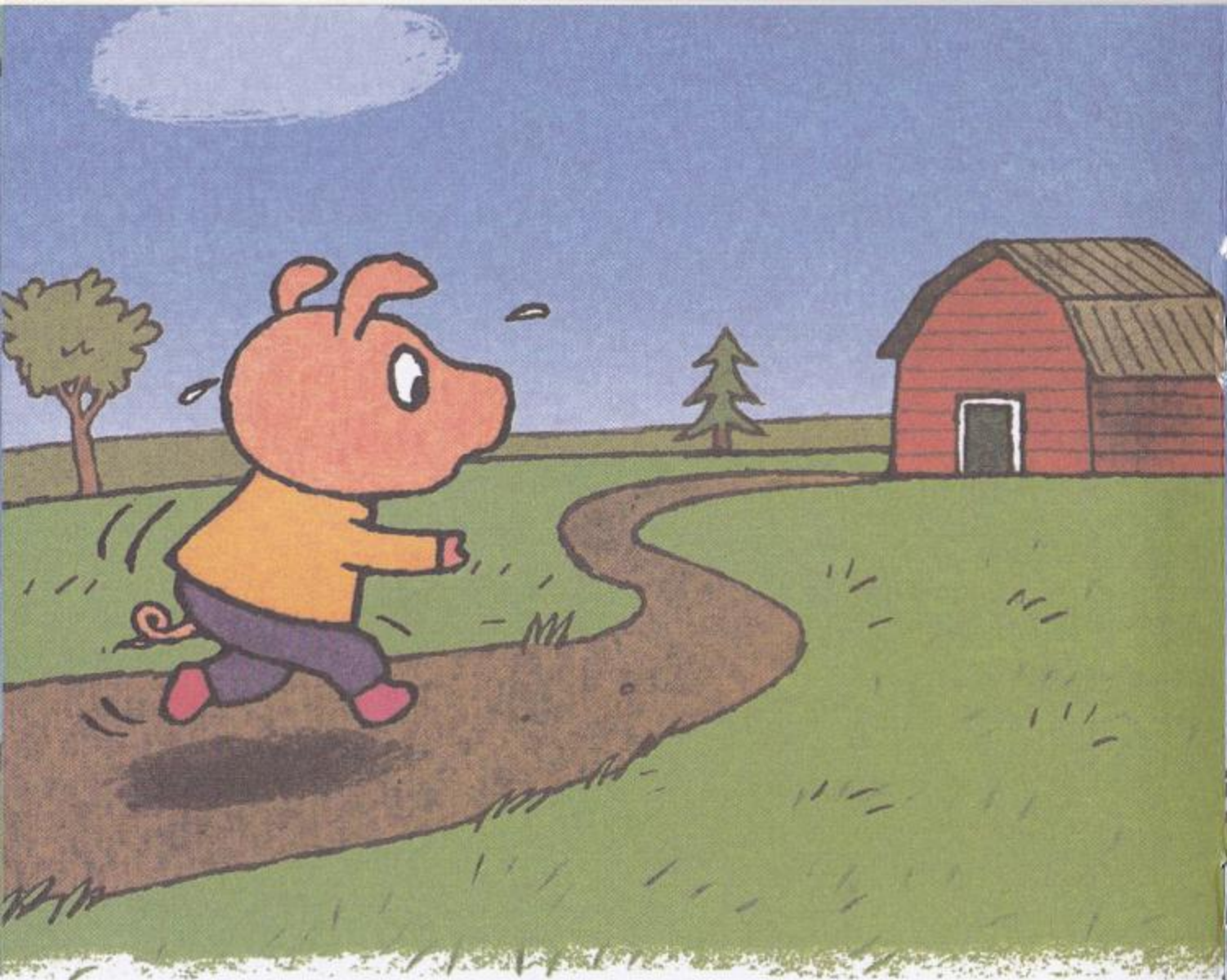


Nat tries to climb down.
