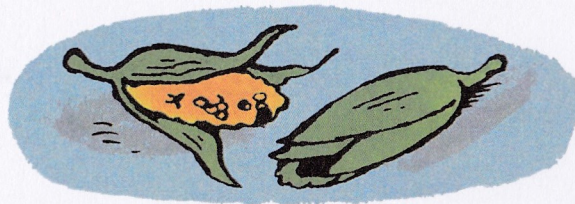

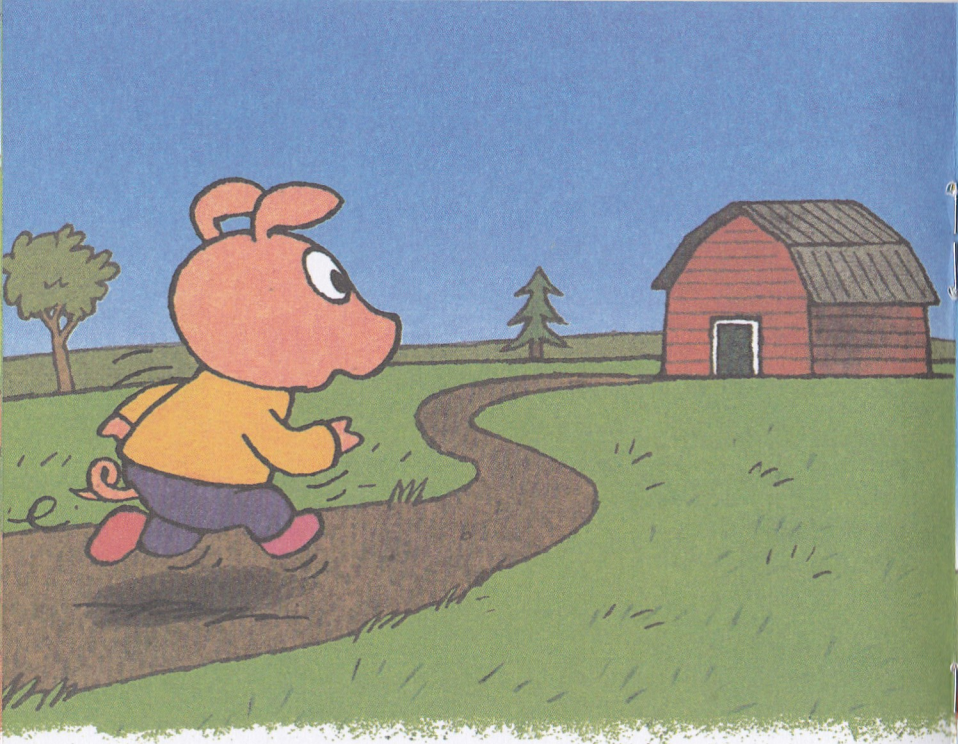

Big Pig is hungry.



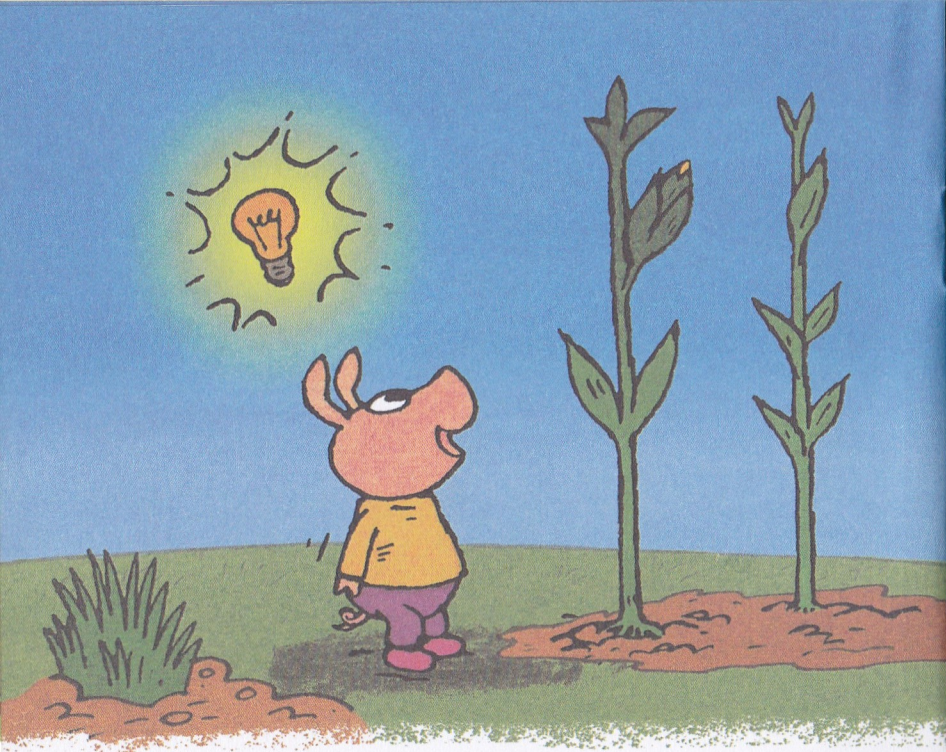
Big Pig wants to eat

asks Big Pig.



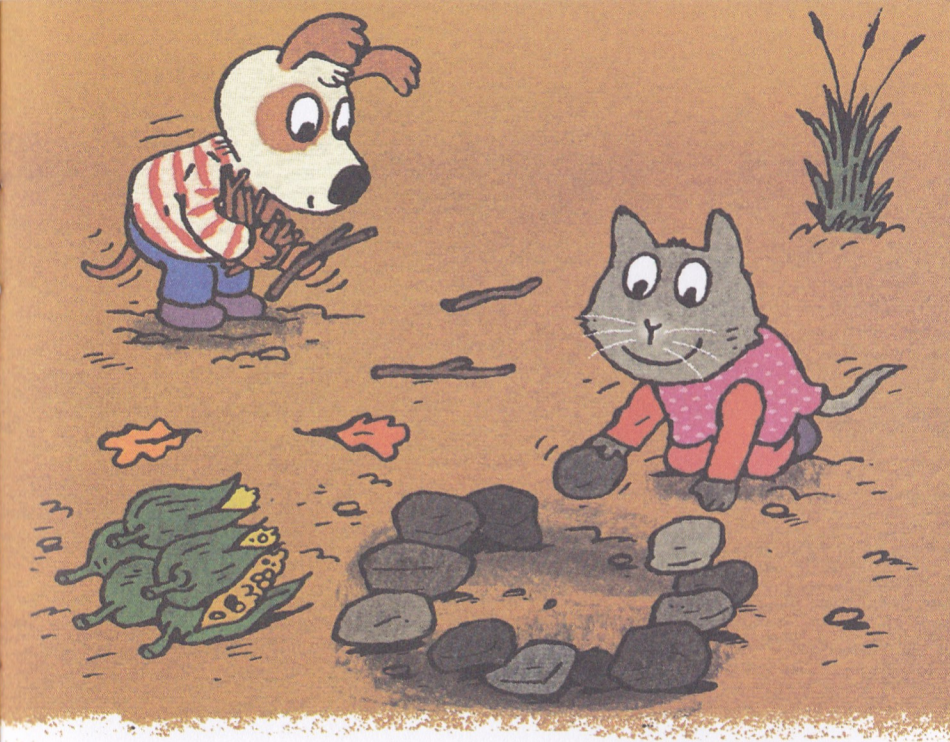
Then Big Pig has

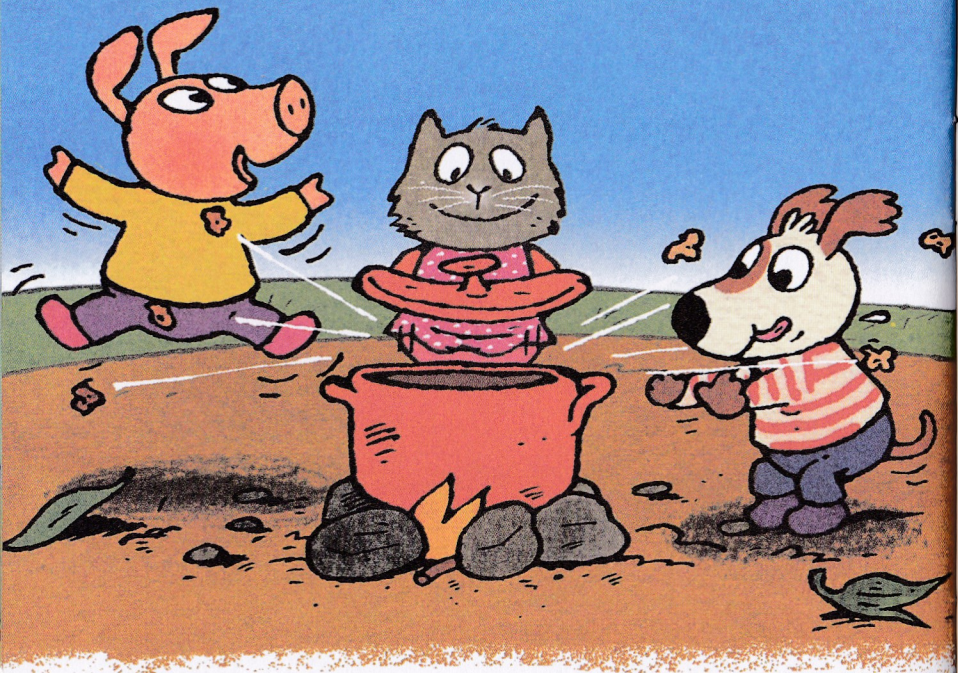
Big Pig shakes and shakes
