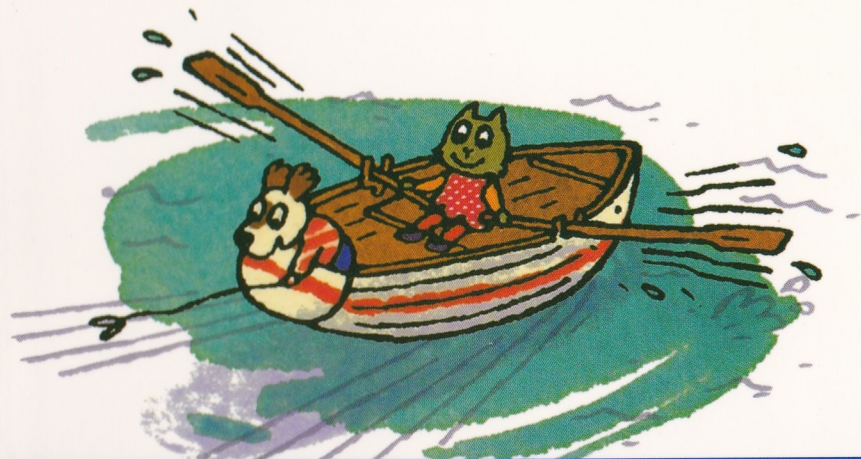

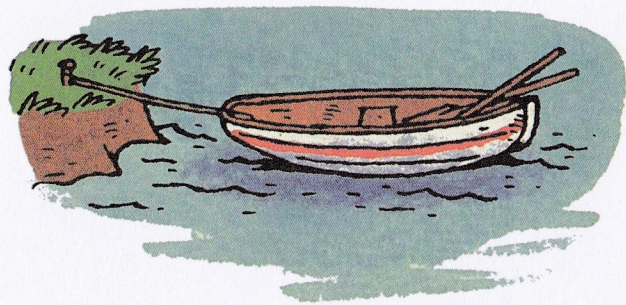

in the bowls.



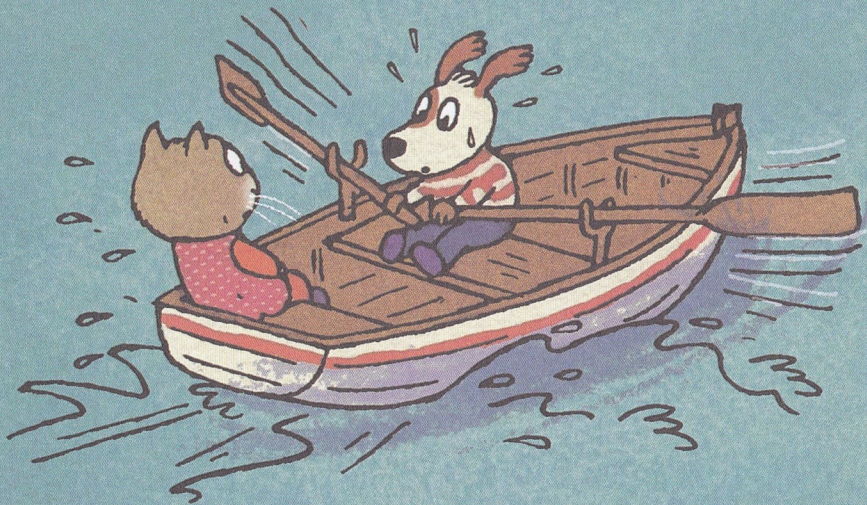
The boat rocks this way and

Rereading the Book Together

More Learning

Act out the part of the story together where Nat and Tug think they see snakes in the water. Have your child illustrate this scene.
