He bounces on a pogo stick.

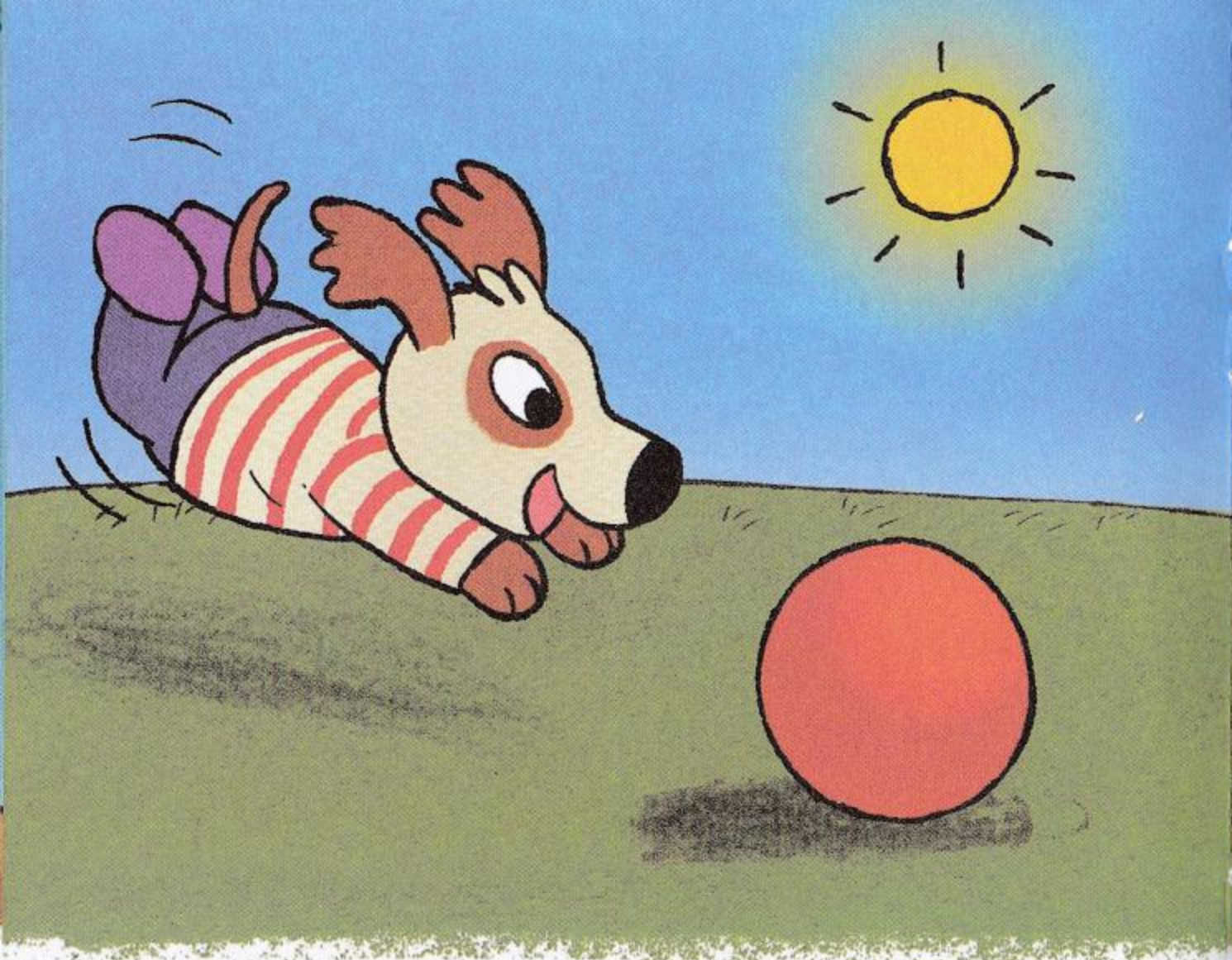
His shadow can bounce, too.



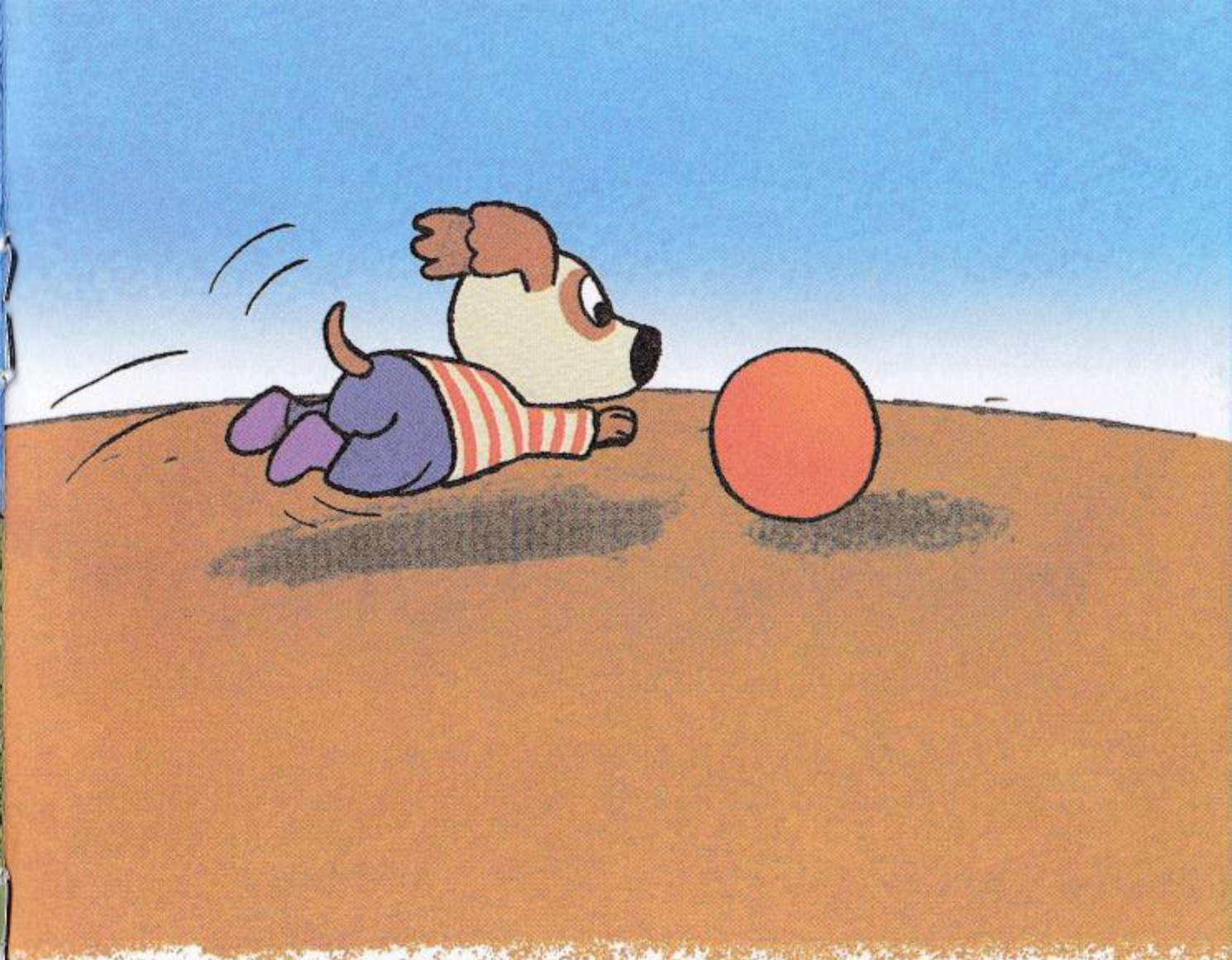
Tug the Pup can hop.

Tug the Pup can sneak up on Big Pig. He tiptoes over to Big Pig.



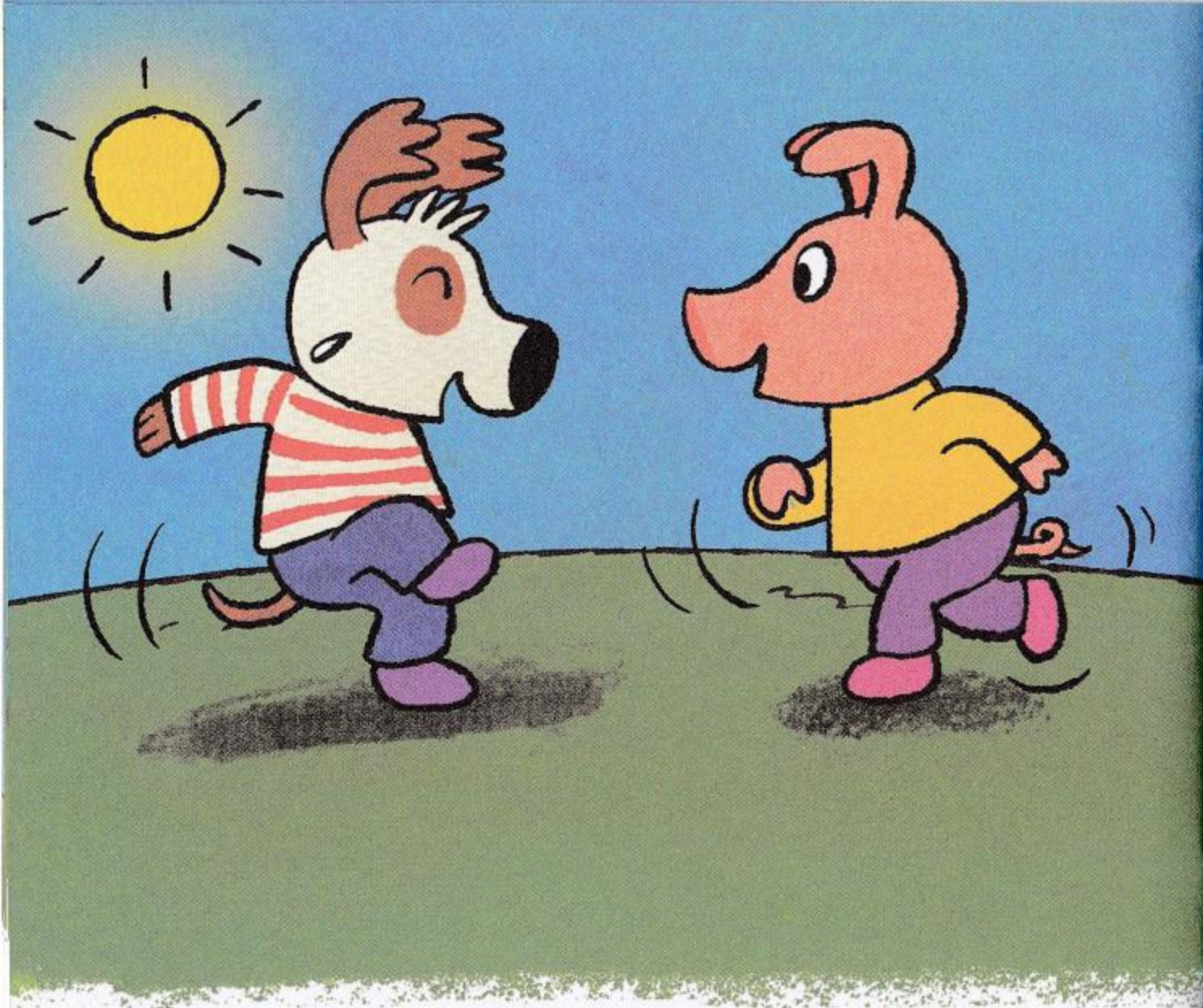
His shadow can sneak up on Big Pig, too.

Rereading the Book Together

Take turns rereading the story, with one of you reading the sentences about Tug and the other reading the sentences about Big Pig. Why was Big Pig scared?

Fun with Words

Have fun acting out the action words in the story: *bounce*, *hop*, *pounce*, and the phrase “*sneak up on*.” Even better: arrange the lighting so your shadows can play along.

More Learning
