"It is Friday. Pen Hen is giving dance lessons," said Tug the Pup. "She's a talented dancer."


Pen Hen teaches a pair of foxes how to dance the fox-trot. "Slow, slow. Quick, quick! Slow, slow. Quick, quick!"






Pen Hen teaches a pair of rabbits how to dance the bunny hop.
