Word Problem



It takes the workers 20 <u>years</u> to build a mall. They have been building one mall for half a <u>decade</u>. How many more years do they need to finish the mall?

$$10 \div 2 = 5$$
 years


20 – 5 = 15 years
They need 15 more years.
