Word Problem

It takes the workers 20 years to build a mall. They have been building one mall for half a decade. How many more years do they need to finish the mall?

$$10 \div 2 = 5 \text{ years}$$

$$20 - 5 = 15 \text{ years}$$

They need 15 more years.

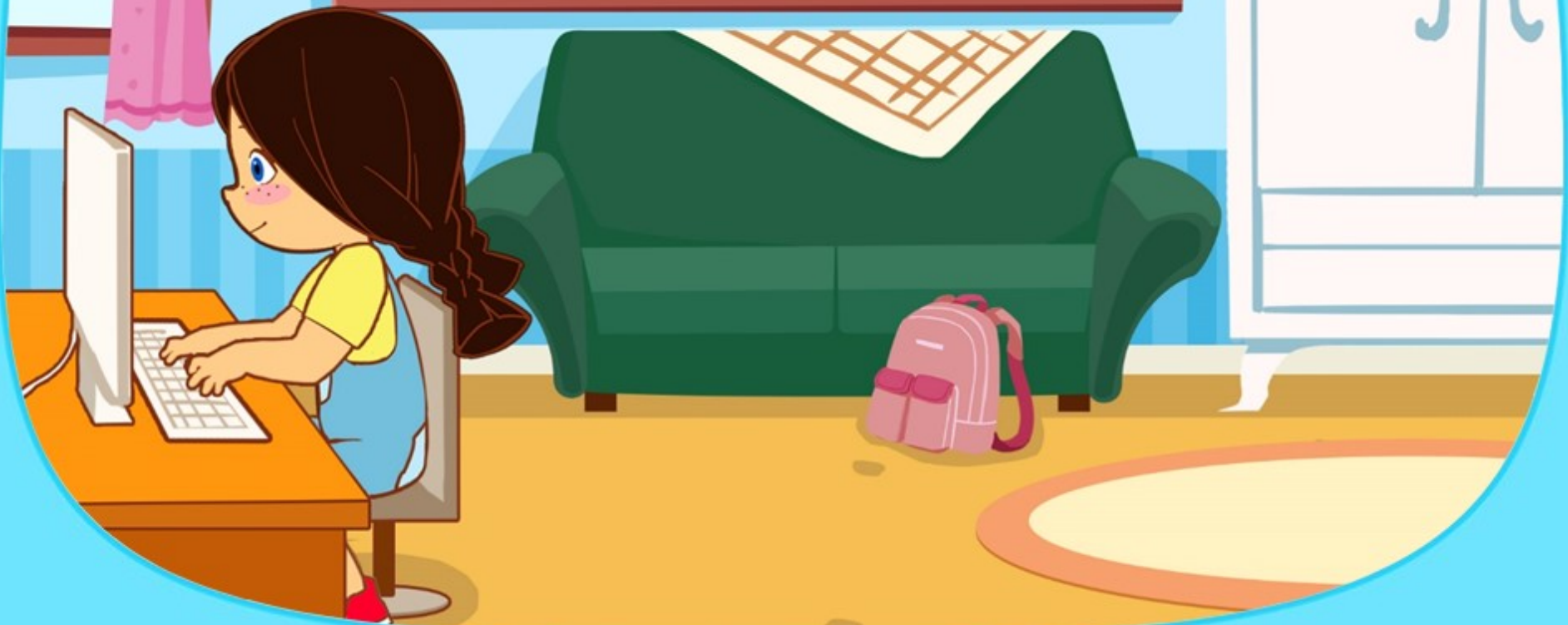
