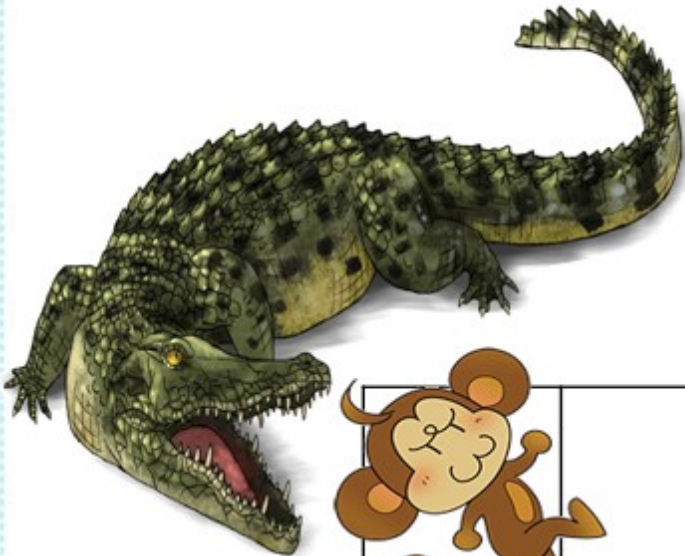

Xicheng **District**



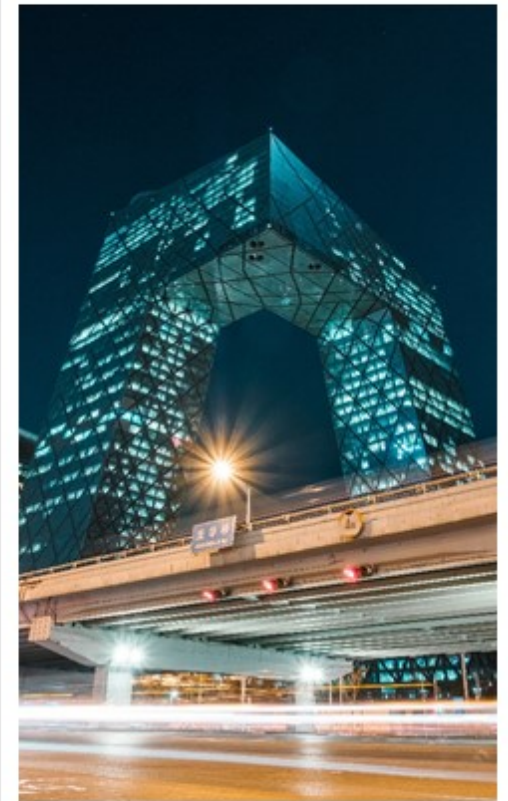

# Overpass



An **overpass** is a bridge above a road. Some overpasses are there to help people cross busy streets safely.

# Underpass



**Underpasses** are roads or sidewalks that go under other streets. People can walk through some **underpasses**, and these often connect to the subway. There are also **underpasses** for cars, buses, and trains.

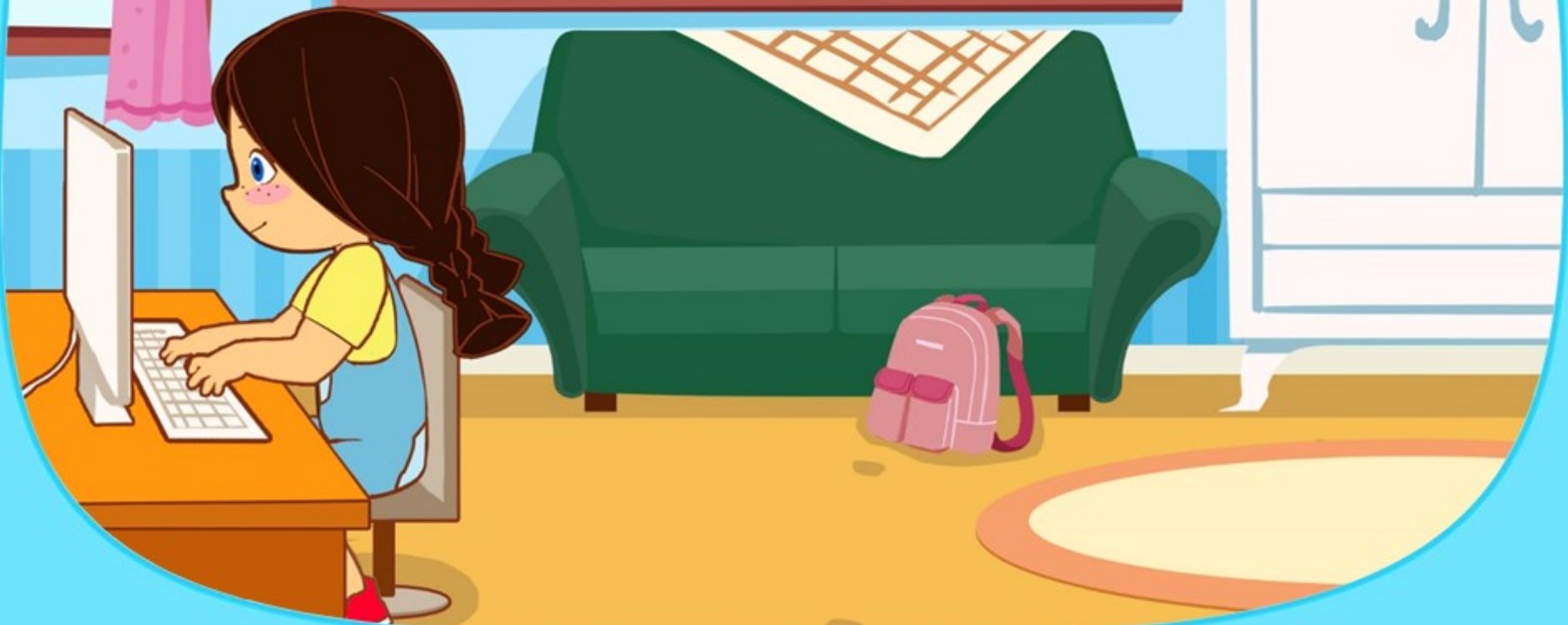
## Option 3 - Information
