

Some ponds are so small that people can jump over them.


A pond is a small body of water with land around it. Ponds are usually smaller than lakes.

Imagine that you are flying around the world. Look down. You see water—a lot of water. In fact, most of the earth is covered by water.


Lakes and ponds are water with land all around them. Ponds are small, and lakes are bigger.




