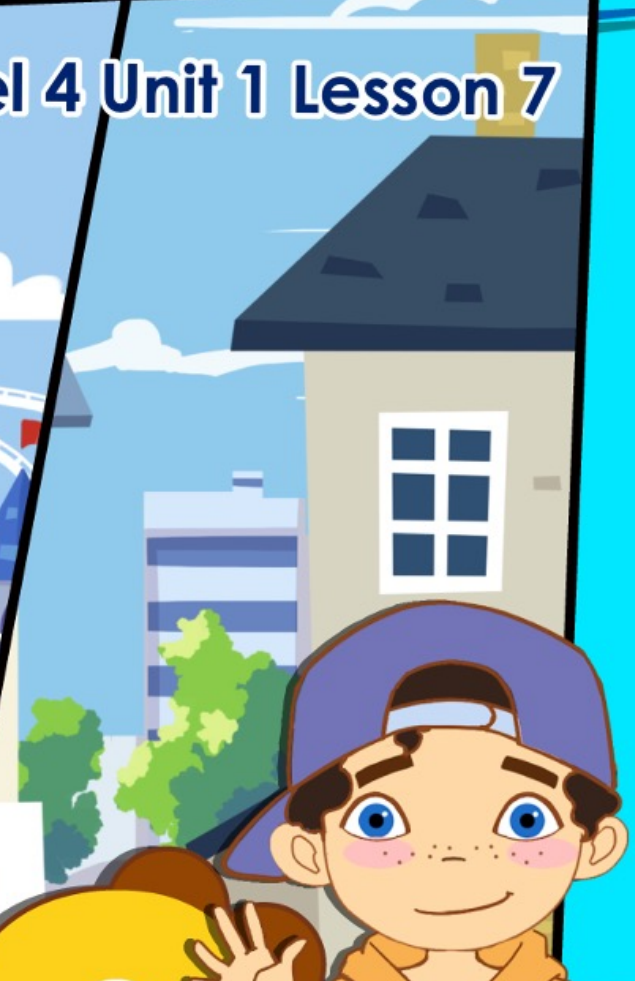

# Bodies of Water



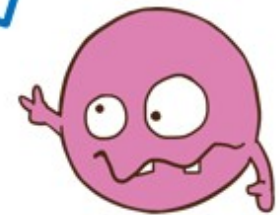
This is a **pond**.

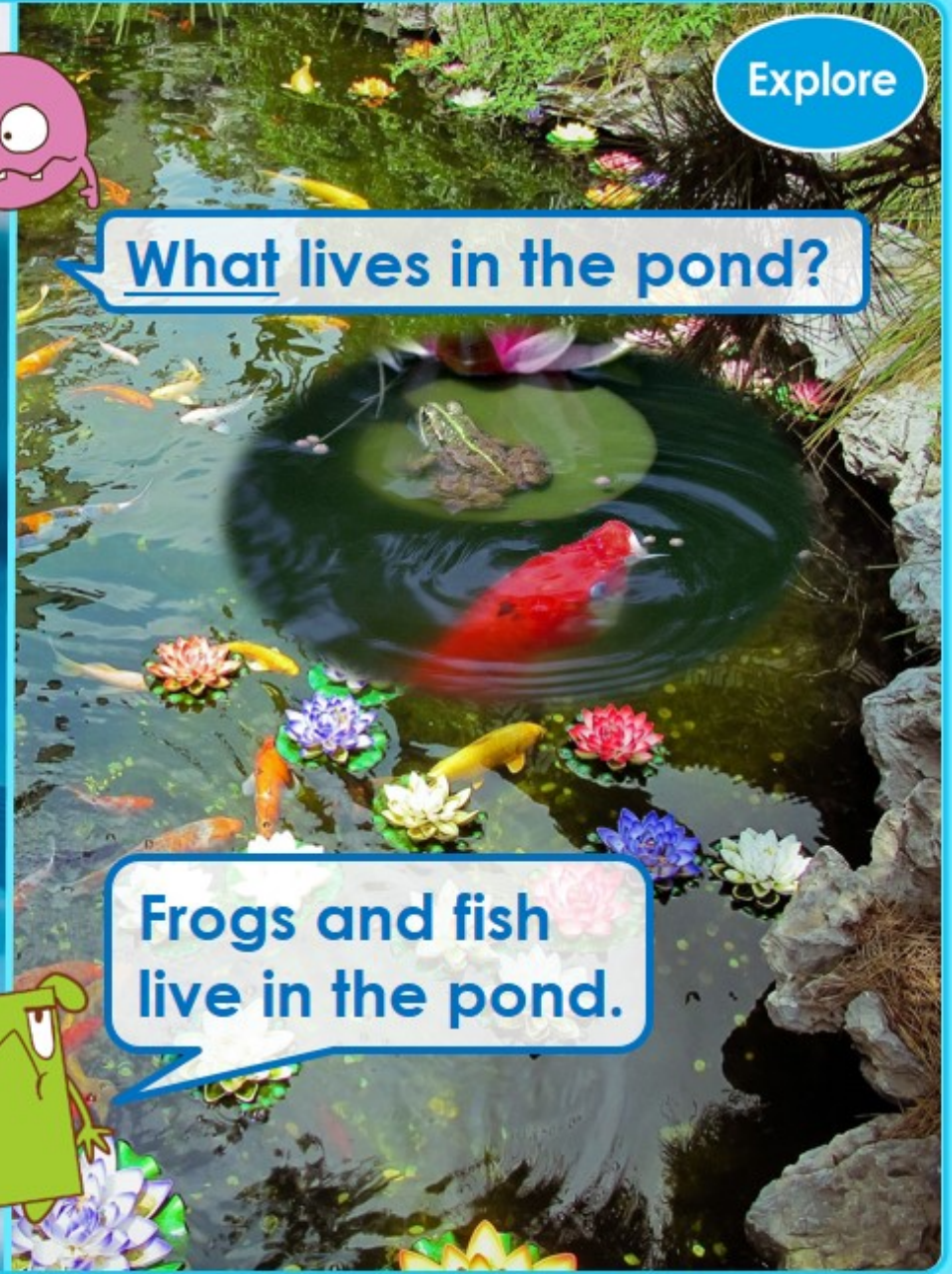

# Lakes and Ponds

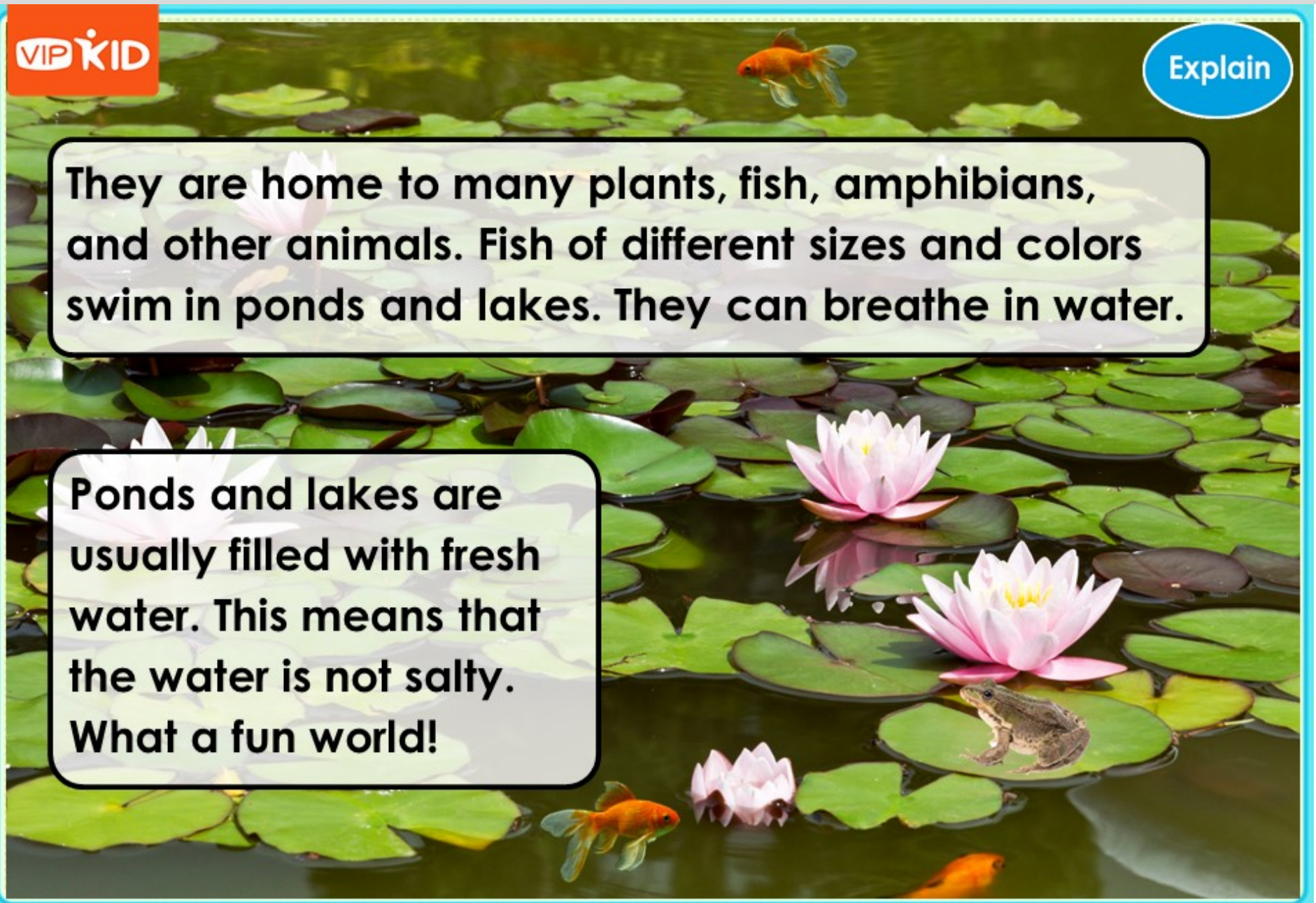
Imagine that you are flying around the world. Look down. You see water—a lot of water. In fact, most of the earth is covered by water.

**Lakes** and **ponds** are water with land all around them. Ponds are small, and lakes are bigger. A pond or a lake is like a small world. Many things live there.



They are home to many plants, fish, amphibians, and other animals. Fish of different sizes and colors swim in ponds and lakes. They can breathe in water.

Ponds and lakes are usually filled with fresh water. This means that the water is not salty. What a fun world!

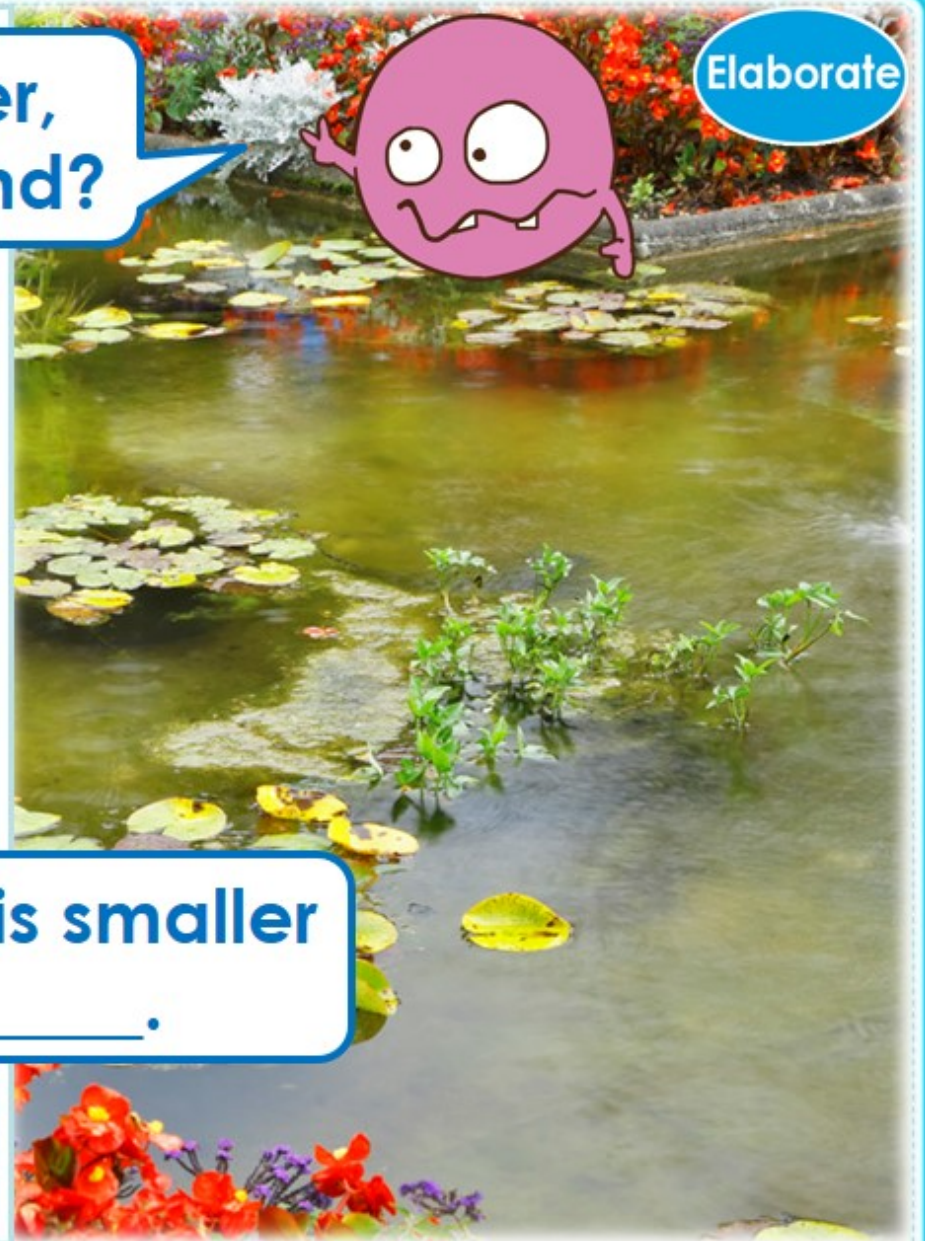

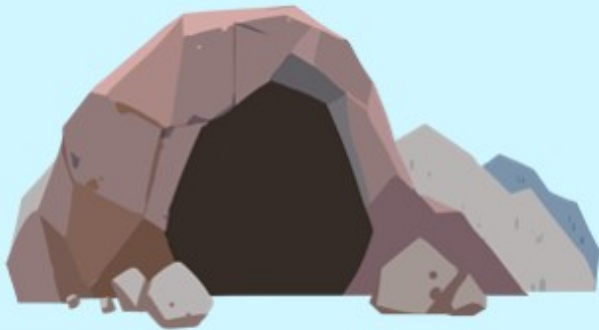

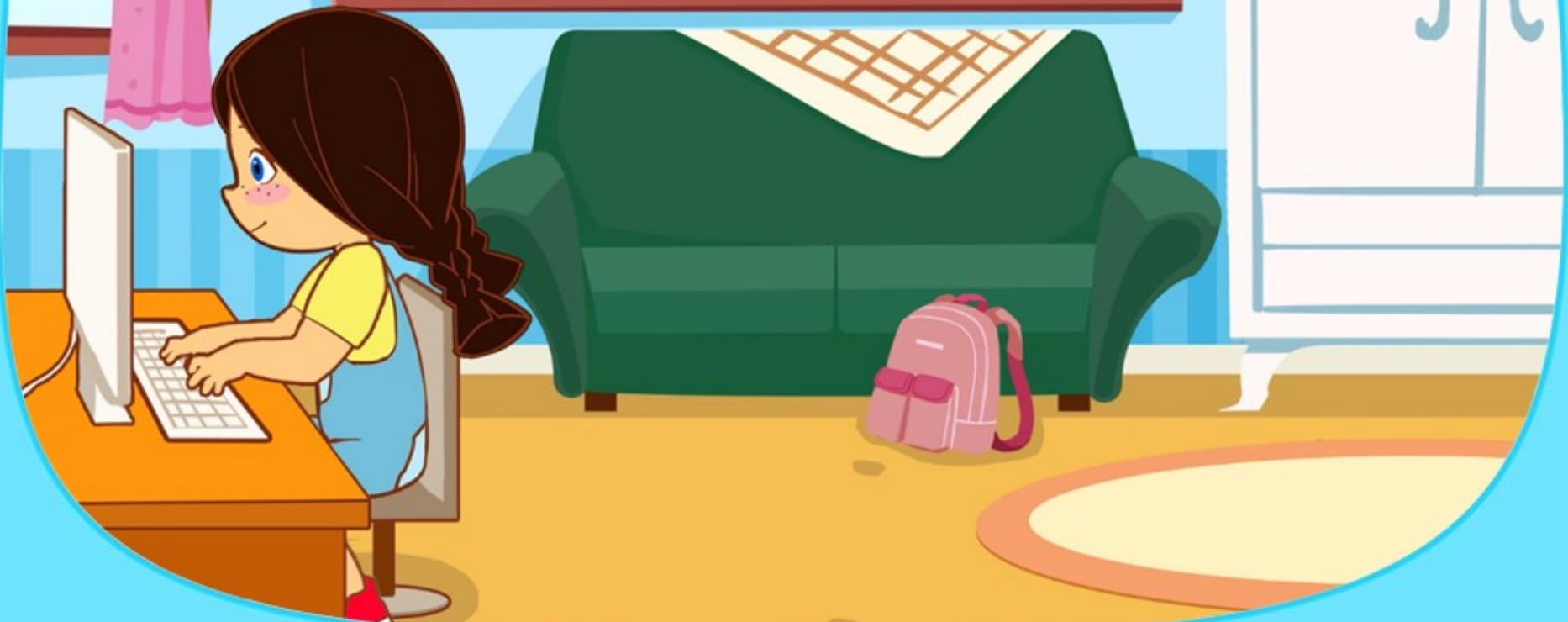
