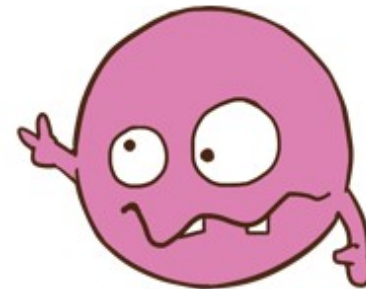
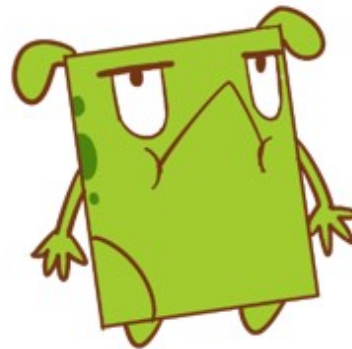
Where does the shark live?

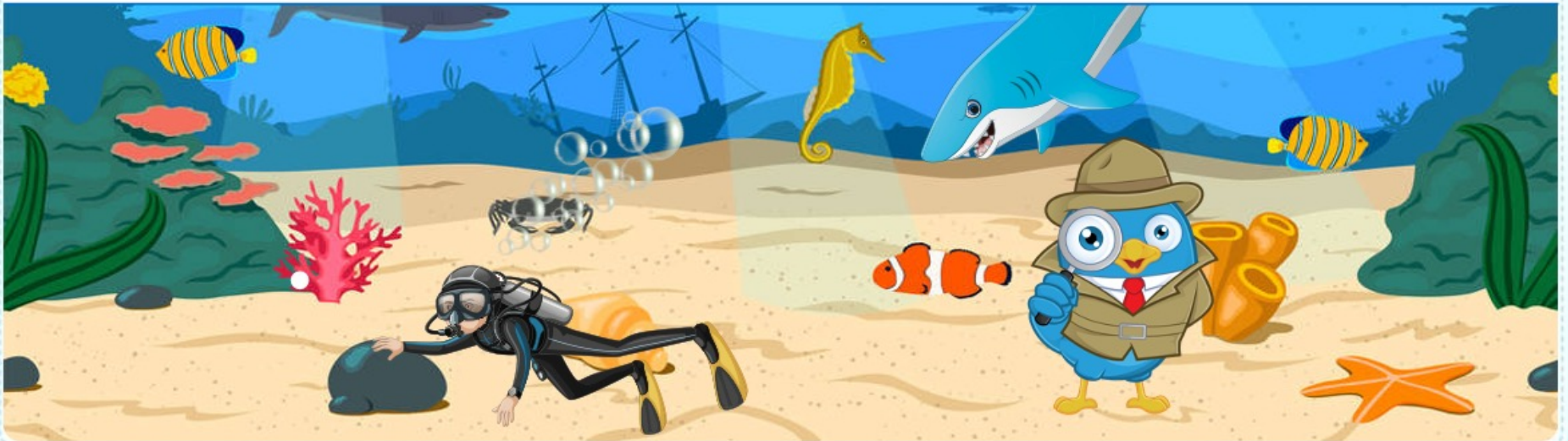
Animals in the Sea
