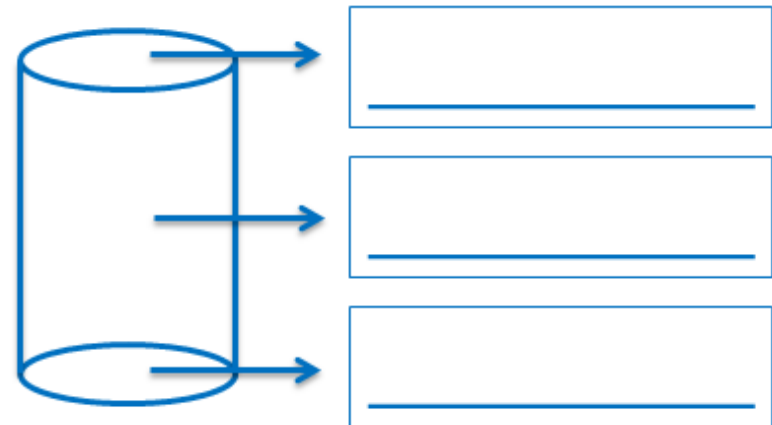
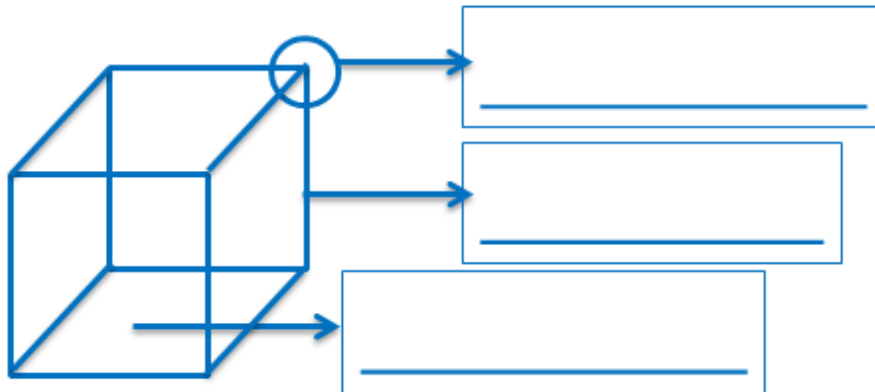


vertex – where 2 or more edges meet

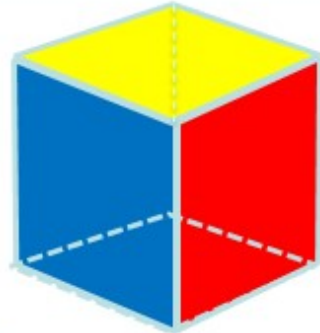
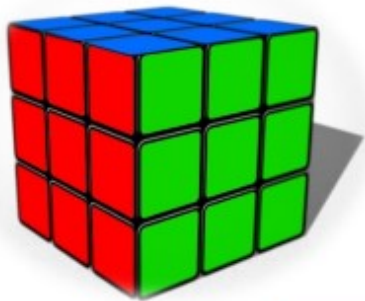

Animals on the Plain

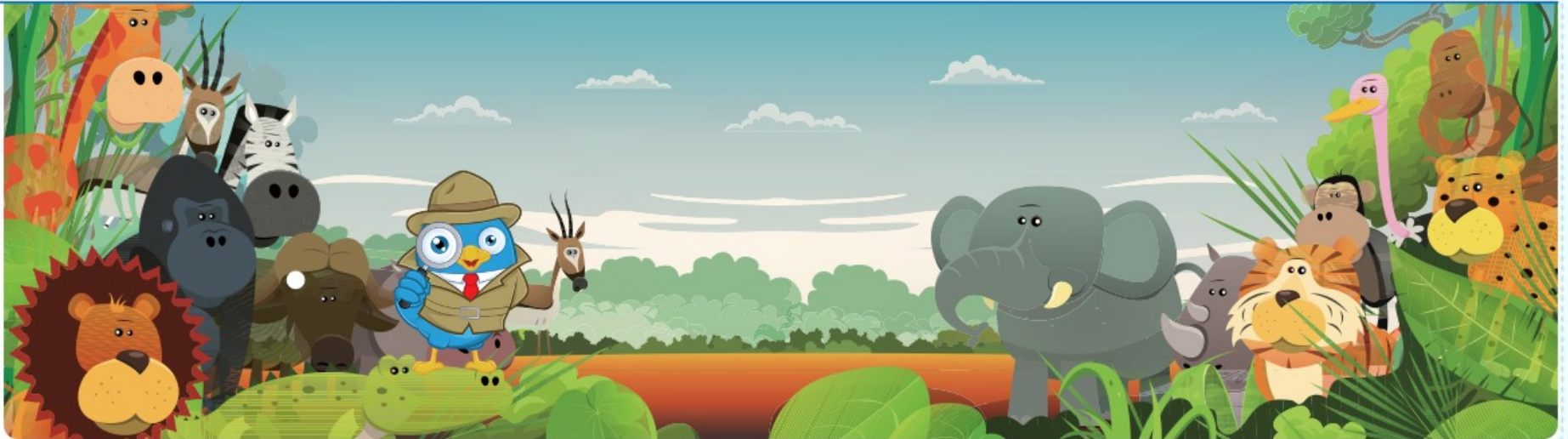
While the elephant was hiding, she fell asleep. A little later, the elephant woke up screaming. She started to cry because she thought the lion ate her trunk and her big ears.
