It was very hot and dry in the desert. Some animals loved living in the desert. They did not need much water, and they liked hot and dry weather.

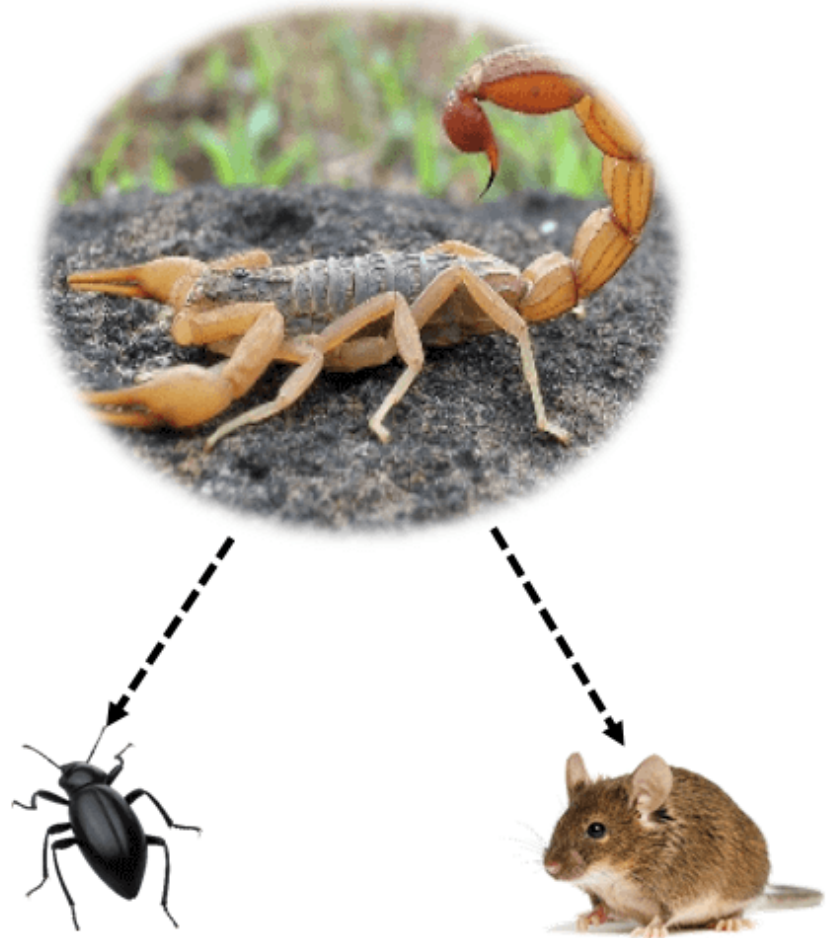
Both **camels** and **scorpions** were living in the desert.

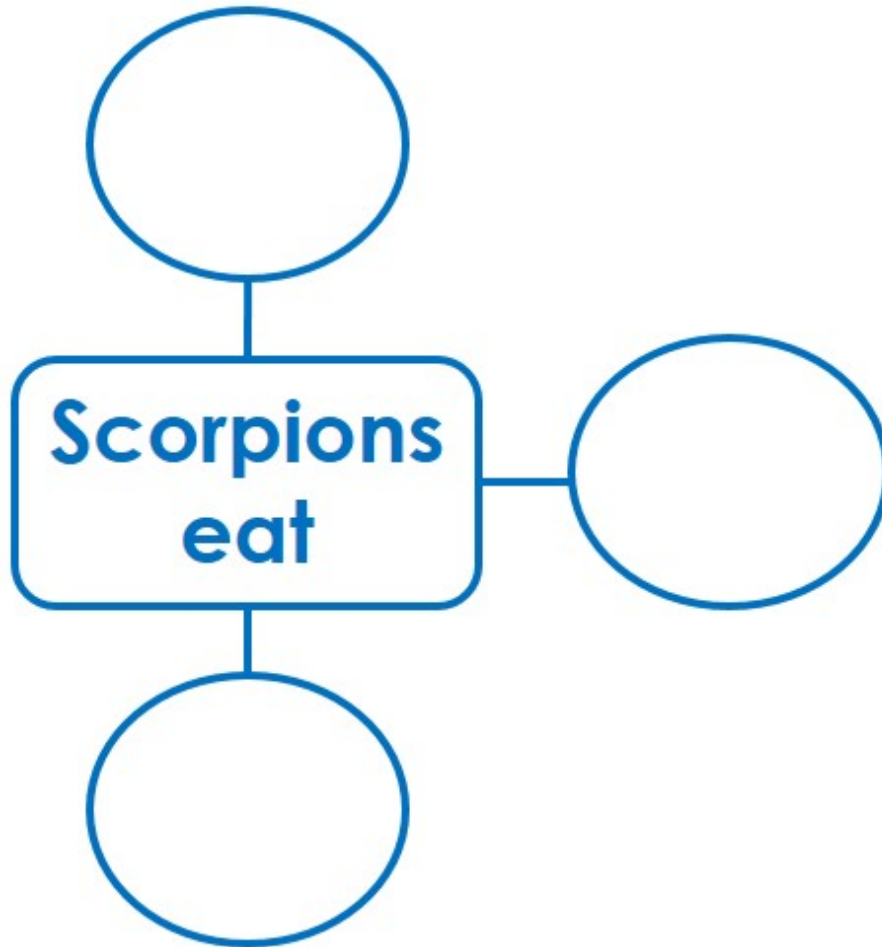

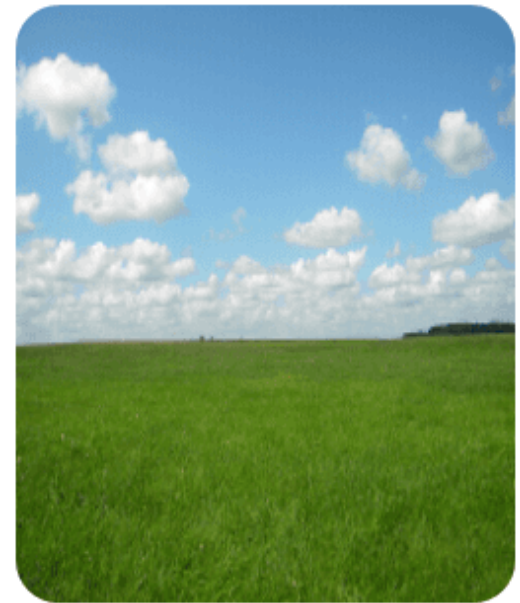

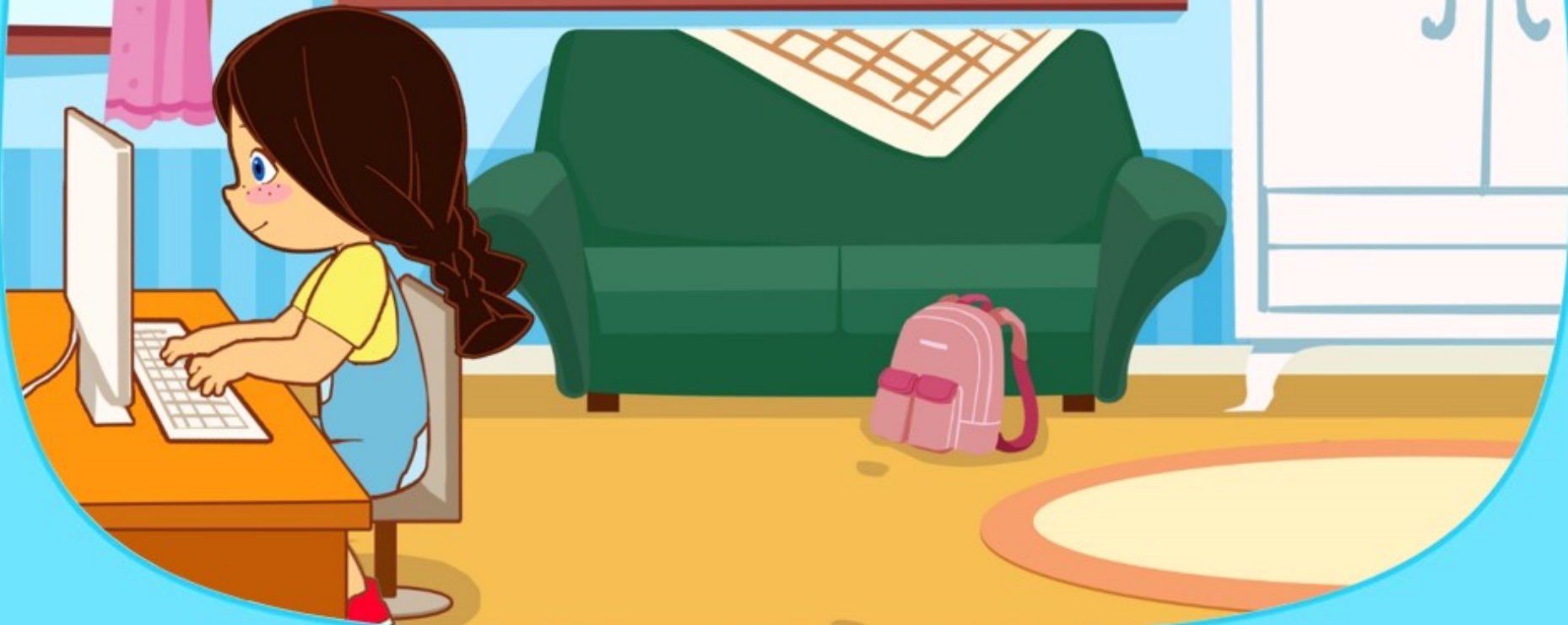
