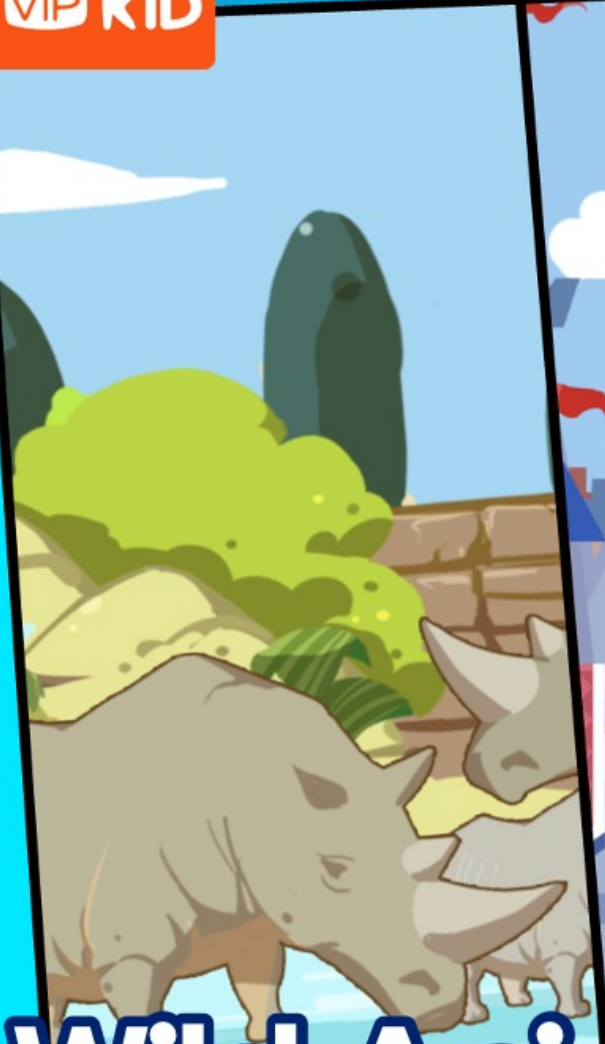

Ocean and Sea Animals

The animals of the seas and oceans find food and water in their habitats.

Sharks eat fish, dolphins, and sometimes even **whales**. Sharks are very strong. Their fins allow them to swim very quickly.

Whales eat a lot of fish. Blue whales are the largest animals in the world. They have been known to grow three times the size of a bus and weigh as much as thirty-three elephants!



Ocean and Sea Animals

Blue whales breathe with their lungs. They use holes on their heads to breathe in oxygen. These holes are similar to the nose of a human. Blue whales sing when they swim. The song can be heard from great distances.

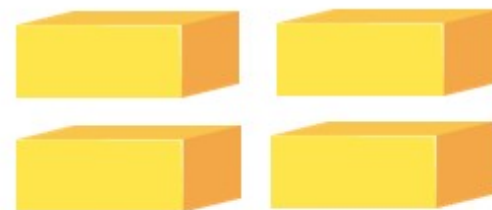
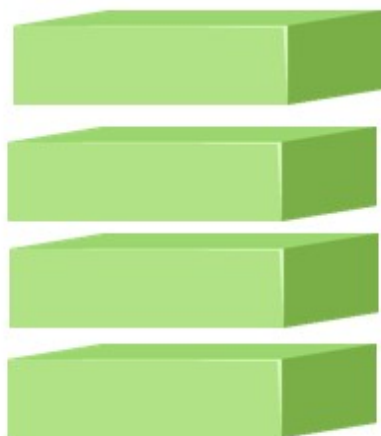
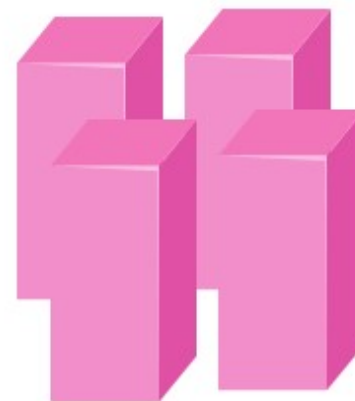
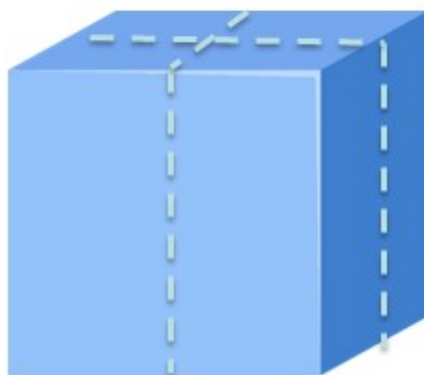
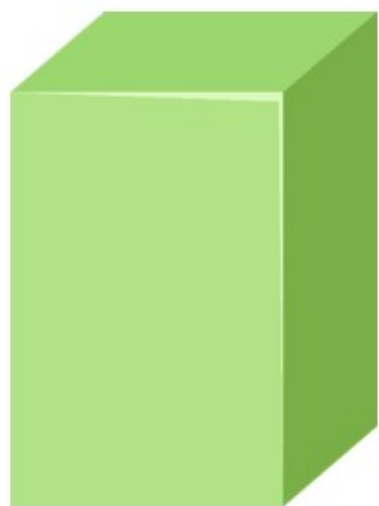
Two cylinders make up a taller cylinder.
