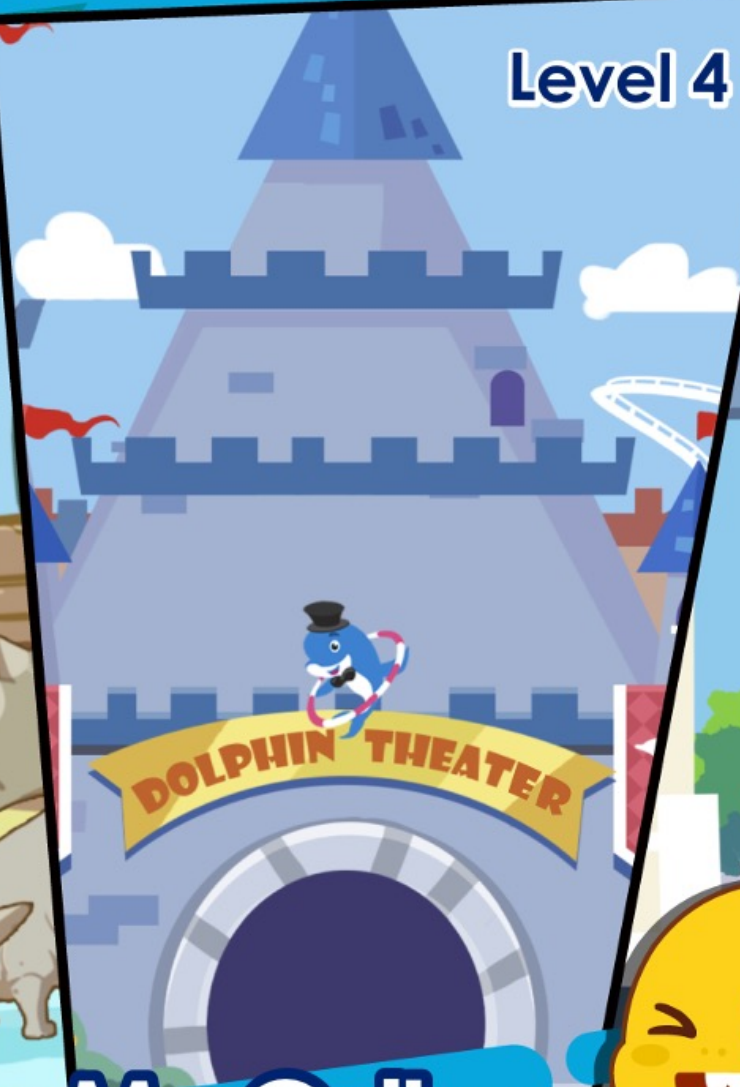

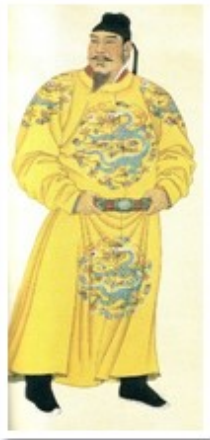

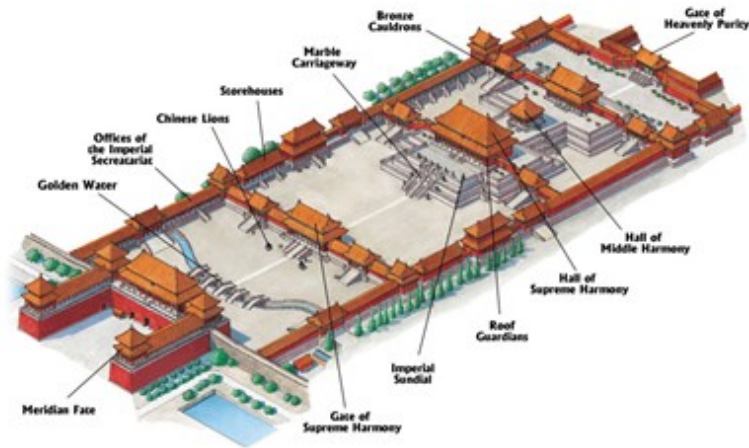


**rule** - to control something
