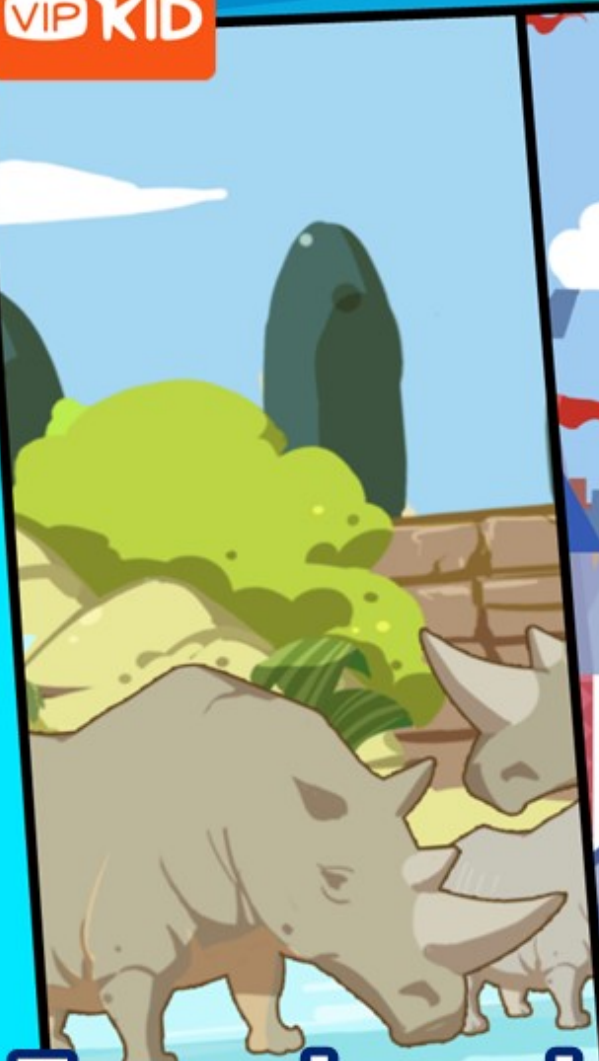
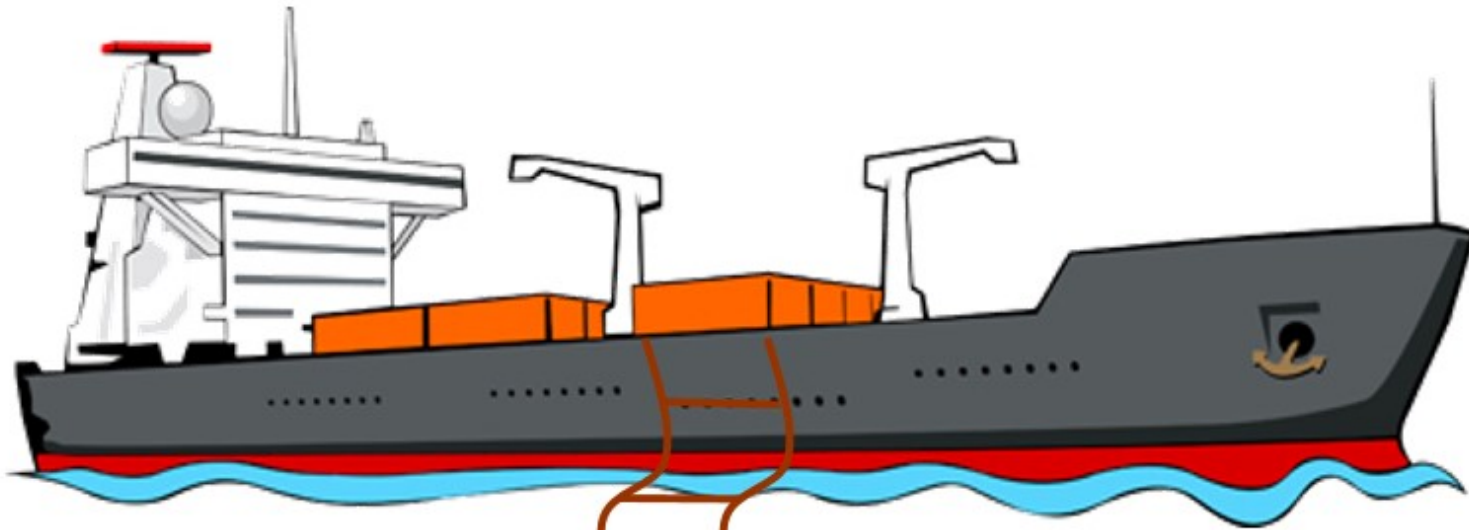

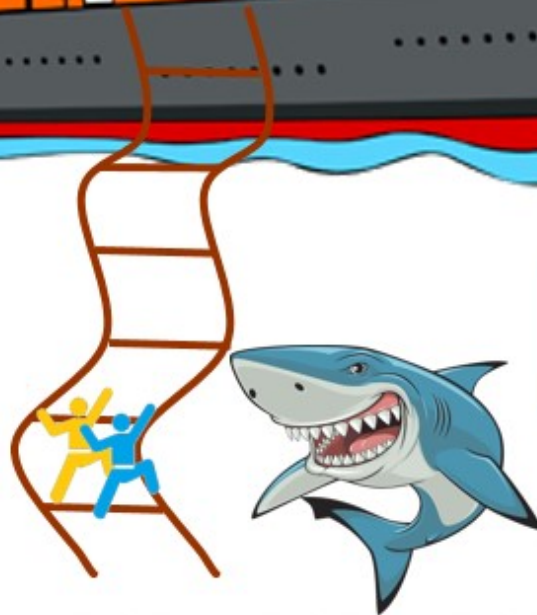

Going to Places

suitcase - a bag for carrying clothes and things when traveling

pack - to put things together in a suitcase to make them easy to carry



Linda and Dennis put their clothes and toys in the **suitcase**. They are **packing** their things.

Going to Places

weigh - to measure how heavy a person or thing is



After packing, Mr. Smith **weighed** the suitcase. It was too heavy, so he took out some things. Then, he **weighed** the suitcase again.

Go to the Airport

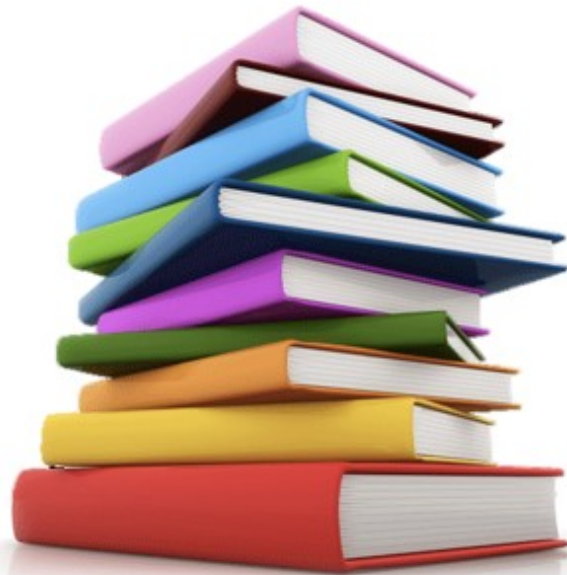
airport - a place where we get on airplanes to fly someplace else

Travelers stand in line to check in with their airlines. They need to show their ID cards or passports to get their tickets.

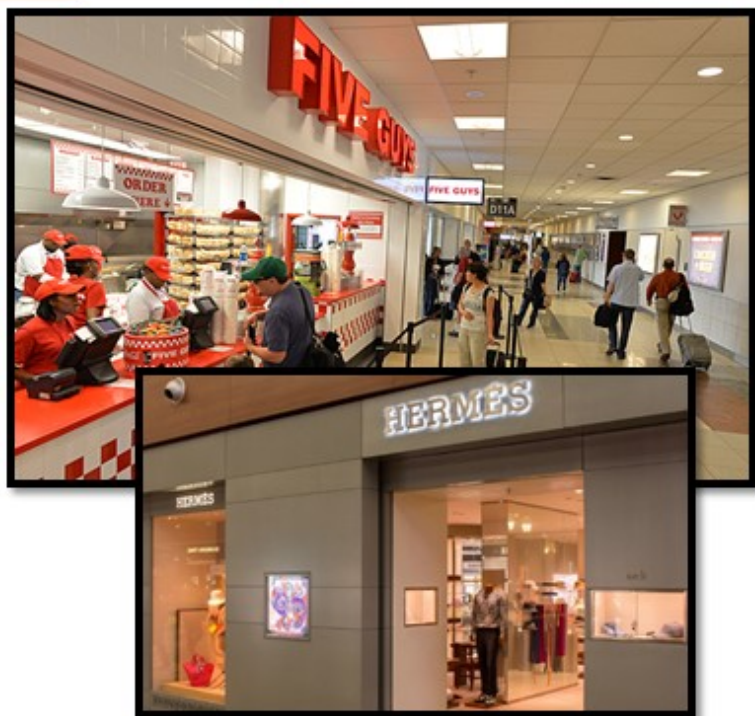




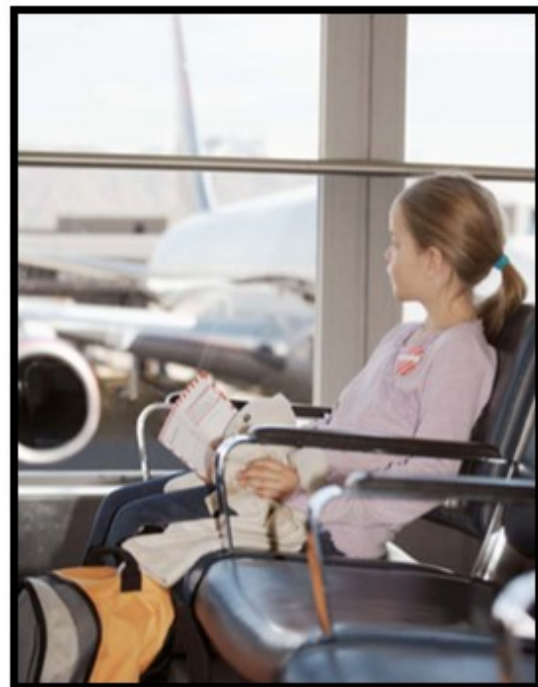
Travelers hand over their **suitcases**. They **weigh** their suitcases to see how heavy they are.

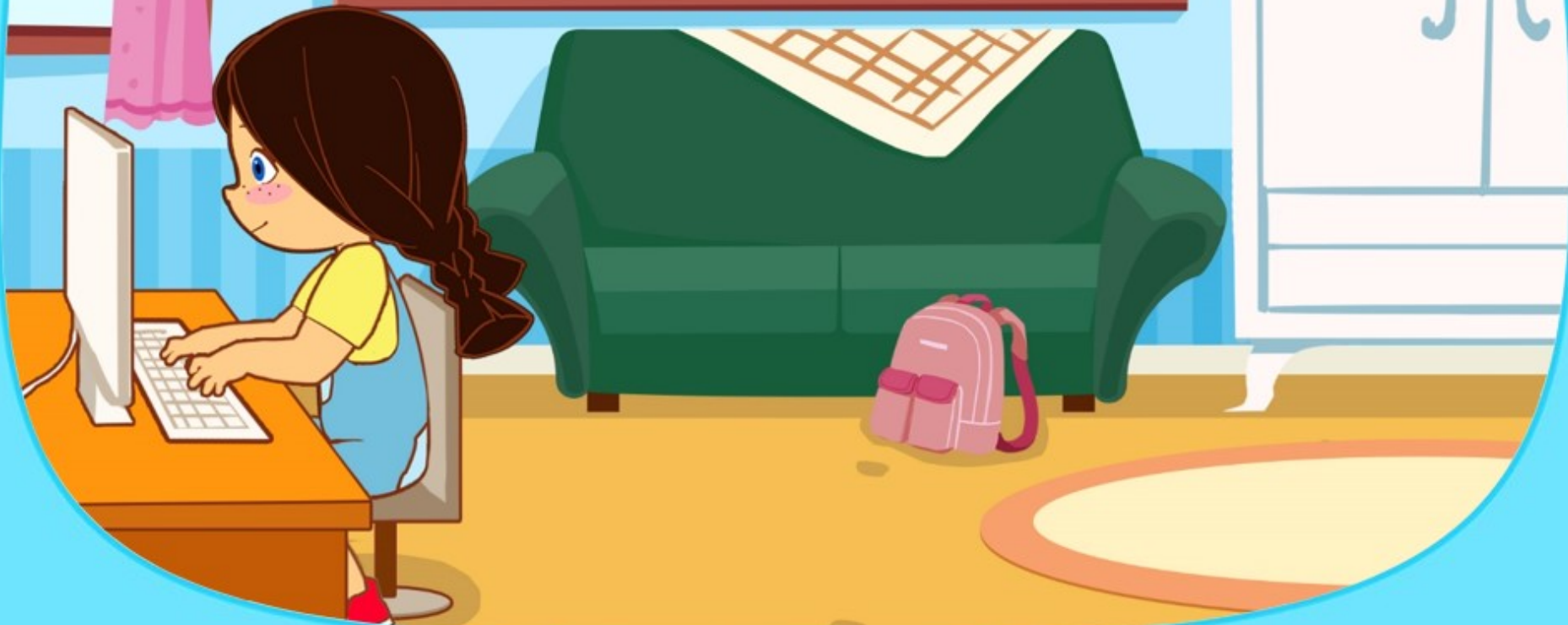
