# Multiplication

$$4 \times 2 = 8$$

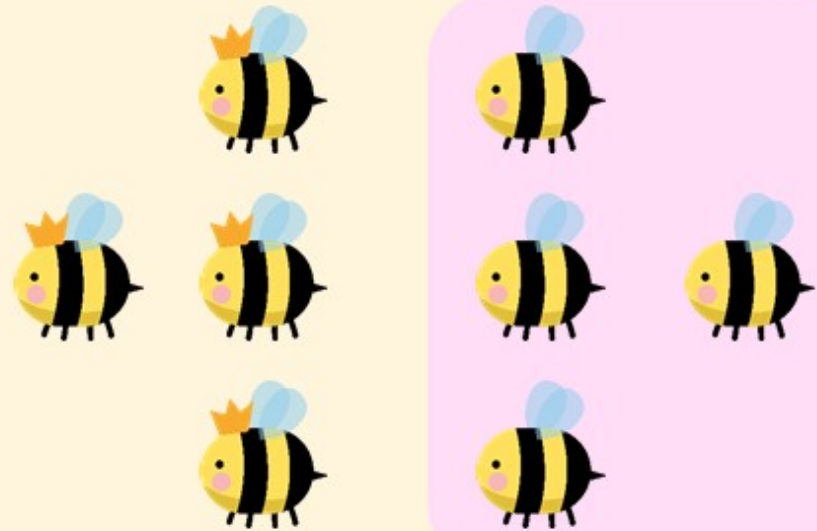


Four **times** two equals eight.

Four **multiplied by** two equals eight.

# Division

$$8 \div 2 = 4$$



Eight **divided by** two equals four.

# Word Problem

A class is going on a sightseeing trip in New York City. The teacher buys one map for each of the 10 students. A sightseeing map costs 5 dollars. **How much money do the maps cost?**

$$\text{Step 1: } 10 \times 5 = 50$$

The class has 90 dollars. **How much money do they have left after buying the sightseeing maps?**

$$\text{Step 2: } 90 - 50 = 40$$

The class has 40 dollars left.

# Word Problem

The class sees 4 different attractions. They spend 15 minutes at each attraction.

At the end of the trip they get off the bus to buy burgers. It takes 30 minutes for the class to buy all the burgers. How long is the trip in all?

**A**

$$4 + 15 = 19$$



$$19 + 30 = 49$$

**B**

$$4 \times 15 = 60$$



$$60 + 30 = 90$$

The trip is \_\_\_\_\_ minutes long.

# Word Problem

Maggie finds many odd coins in a museum. There are 80 coins in all. 10 coins are in a bag. The rest of the coins are in boxes.

Each of the boxes holds 14 coins. How many boxes are there?

A

$$80 - 10 = 70$$



$$70 \div 14 = 5$$

B

$$80 + 10 = 90$$



$$90 - 14 = 76$$

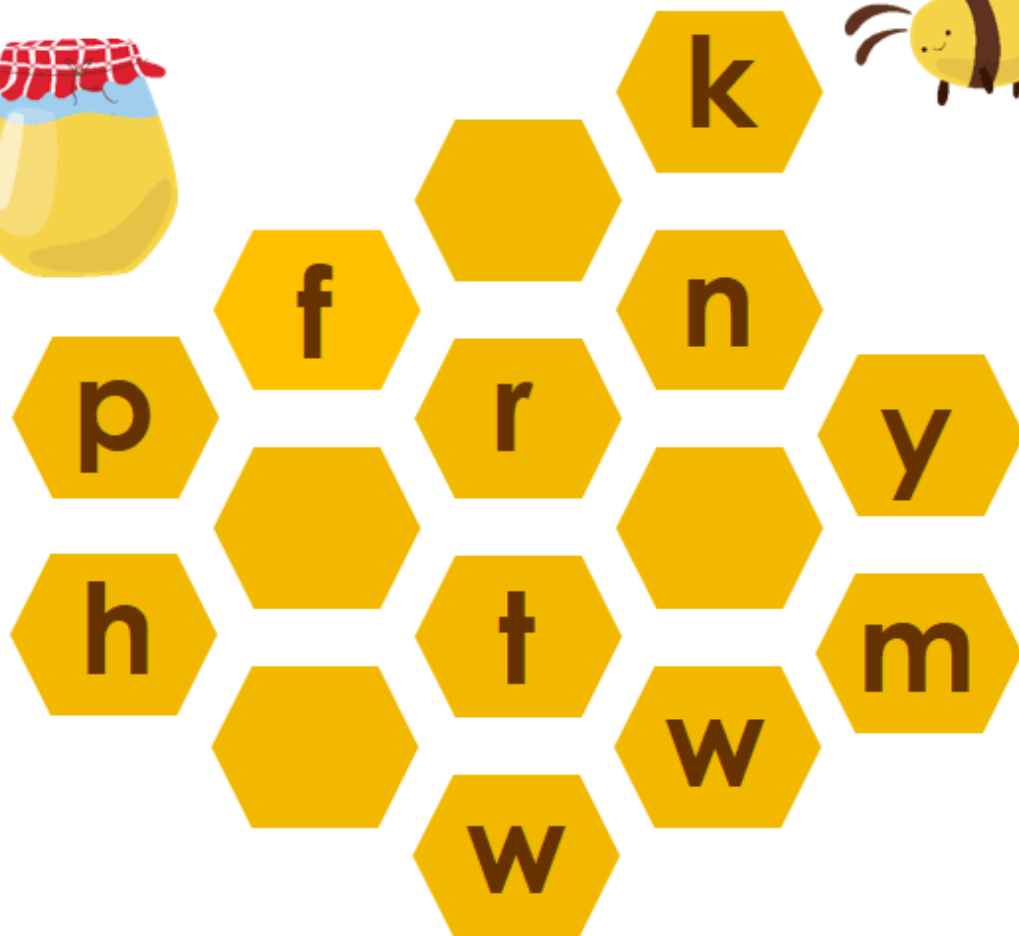
