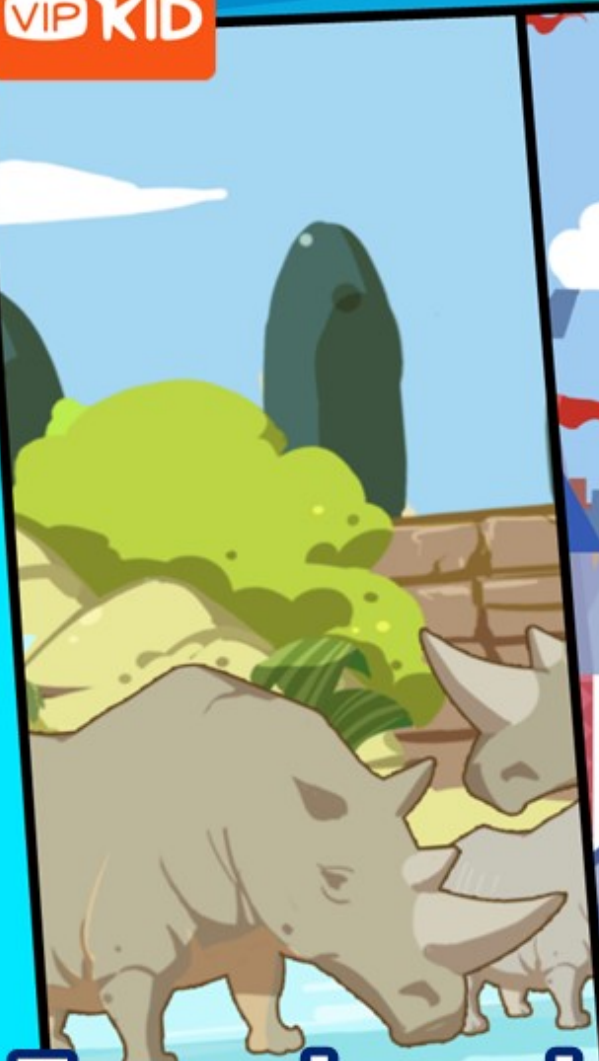

Going to Places



The Smith family will be **tourists** in China.

How do you go to the airport?

taxi - a car that takes people to a place for money



The Smiths take a **taxi** to the airport. They wait at the airport for their plane. Planes land and take off at the airport.

terminal - a building at an airport where people get on and off airplanes

We “add” to solve problems like “How many do we have in all? How many do we have all together?”

Subtraction

$$40 - 12 = 28 \rightarrow \text{subtraction}$$

$$10 - 7 = 3$$

$$32 - 12 = 20$$

$$16 - 8 = 8$$

Tips

We “subtract” to solve problems like “How many are left?”

Let's Think About It

Tom packs 2 pairs of pants. Lucy packs 3 shirts.
How many clothing items do they pack in all?



equal sign



$$2 + 3 = 5$$



plus sign

They pack 5 clothing items in all.

Word Problem

Mrs. Smith weighed her family's suitcases for their trip. They could only pack 45 kg. Their suitcases weighed 20 kg. How many kilograms more could they pack?



$$45 - 20 = 25$$

equal sign

↓

↑

minus sign

They could pack 25 more kilograms.

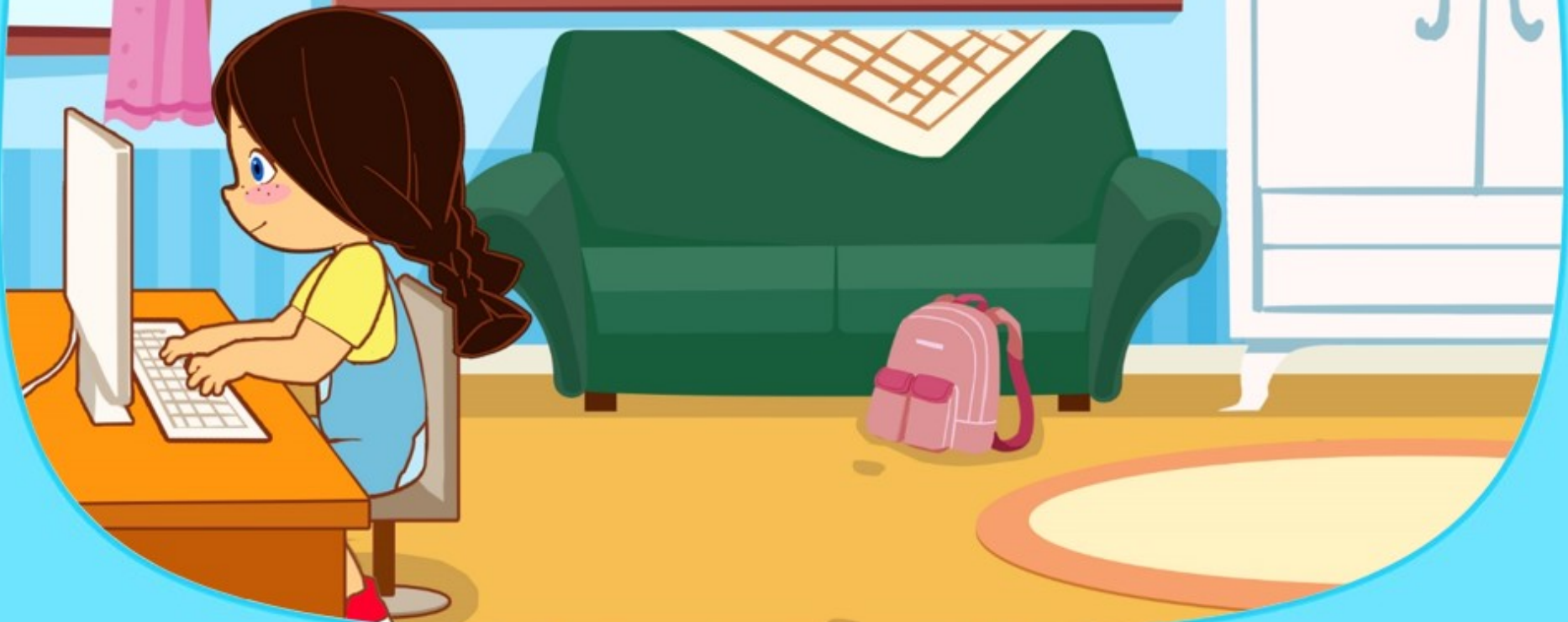
