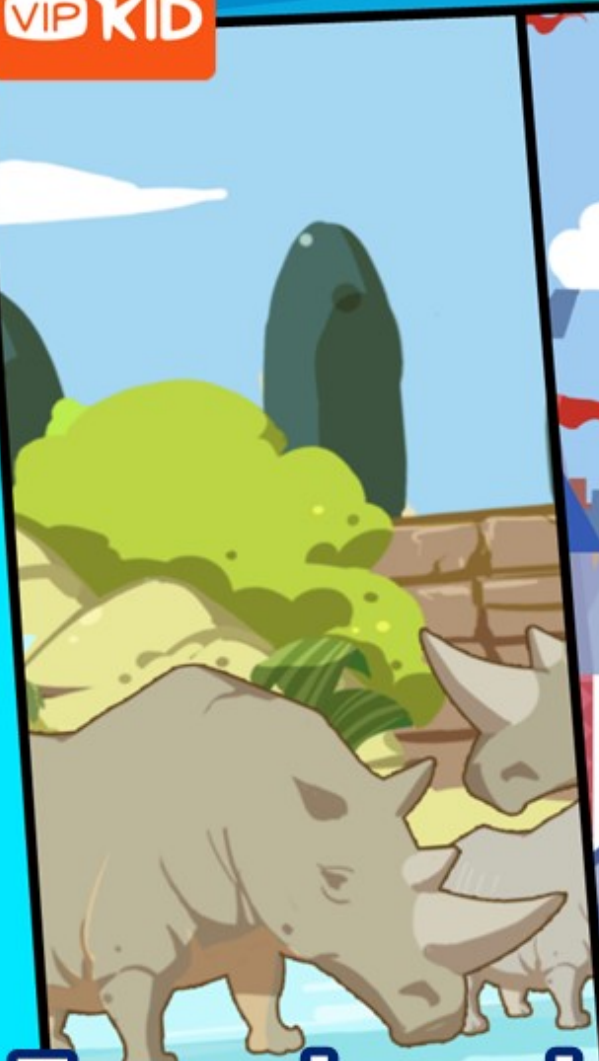

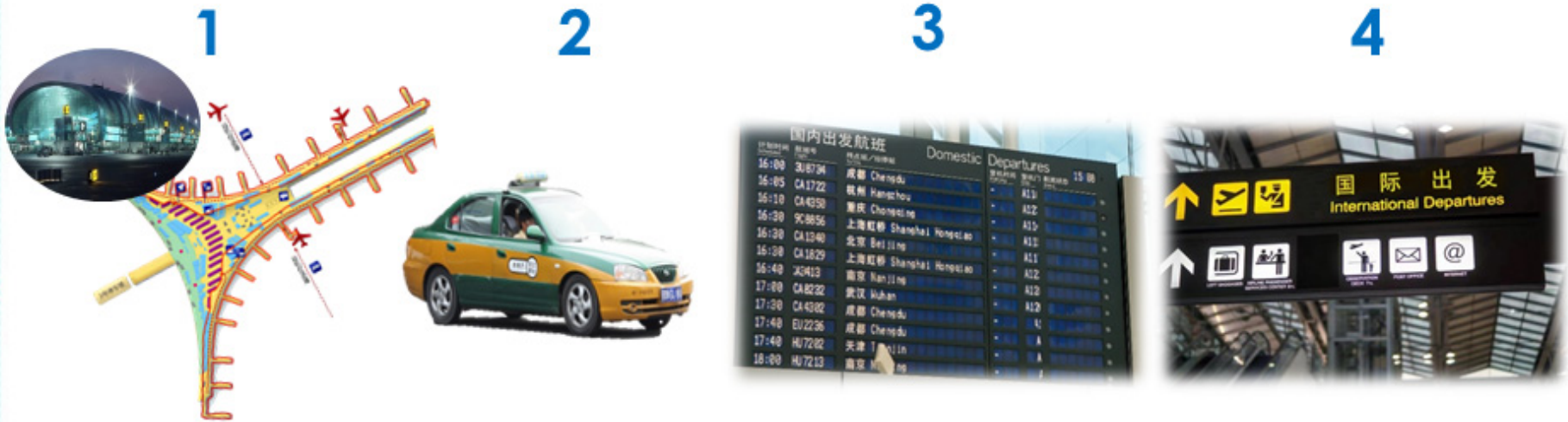

“What is a **boarding pass**?” asks Linda.

# Boarding

**destination** - the place where a person is going



“A boarding pass shows your **destination**,” explains Dennis.

“**Destination**? What is that?” asks Linda.

“Our **destination** is Shanghai. That is where we are flying to,” says Dennis.

# Boarding

**flight attendant** - a person who works on an airplane helping the people and serving food



A **flight attendant** shows the Smith family their seats. “Would you like something to drink? Coffee, tea, or Coca-Cola?”  
“No, thanks.”

# Flying the Plane

**captain** - the person in charge of a ship or an airplane

**pilot** - someone who flies an airplane



“Mom, does the **captain** fly the plane?” asks Linda. “Yes, Linda. The **captain** is in charge. He is also one of the **pilots** of the plane,” says Mrs. Smith. “I am so excited! We are taking off!” says Linda.



# Take Off

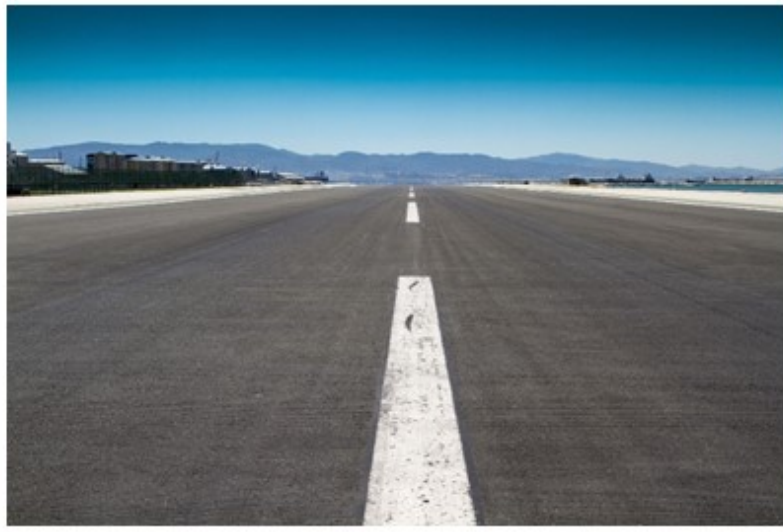
**take off** - when an airplane starts to fly



The pilots start up the plane. Finally, the plane **takes off**.

# On the Way

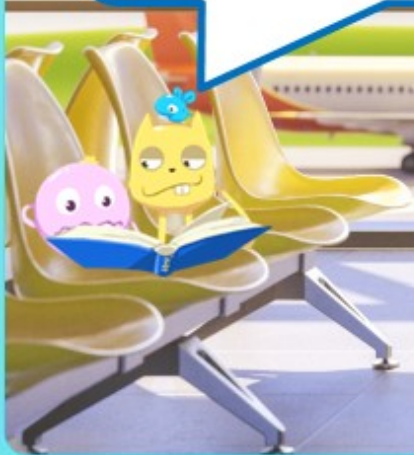
**runway** - a long strip of ground where airplanes take off and land



The **runway** is clear so the plane can take off.  
“Look, the plane is flying now! The kids are very excited.”

Passengers wait in line at the gate of their plane. Where do you think they are going?

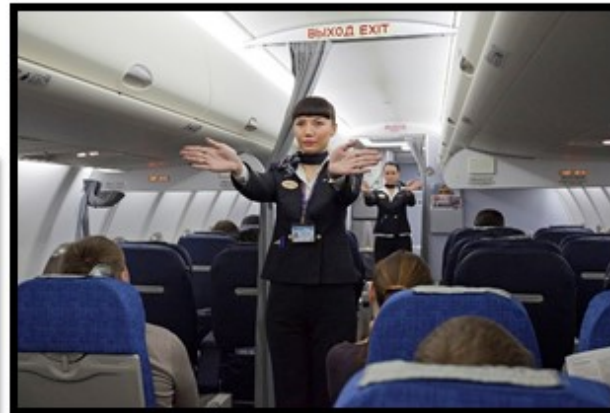


After boarding the plane, all of the travelers search for their seats. Some have window seats. Others have **aisle seats**.

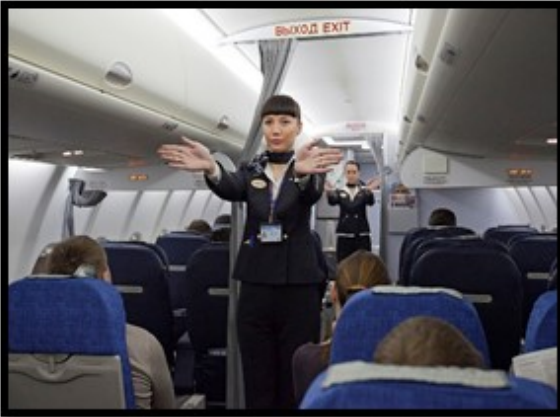


The travelers put their luggage in the **overhead compartment**. The overhead compartment can hold lots of luggage.

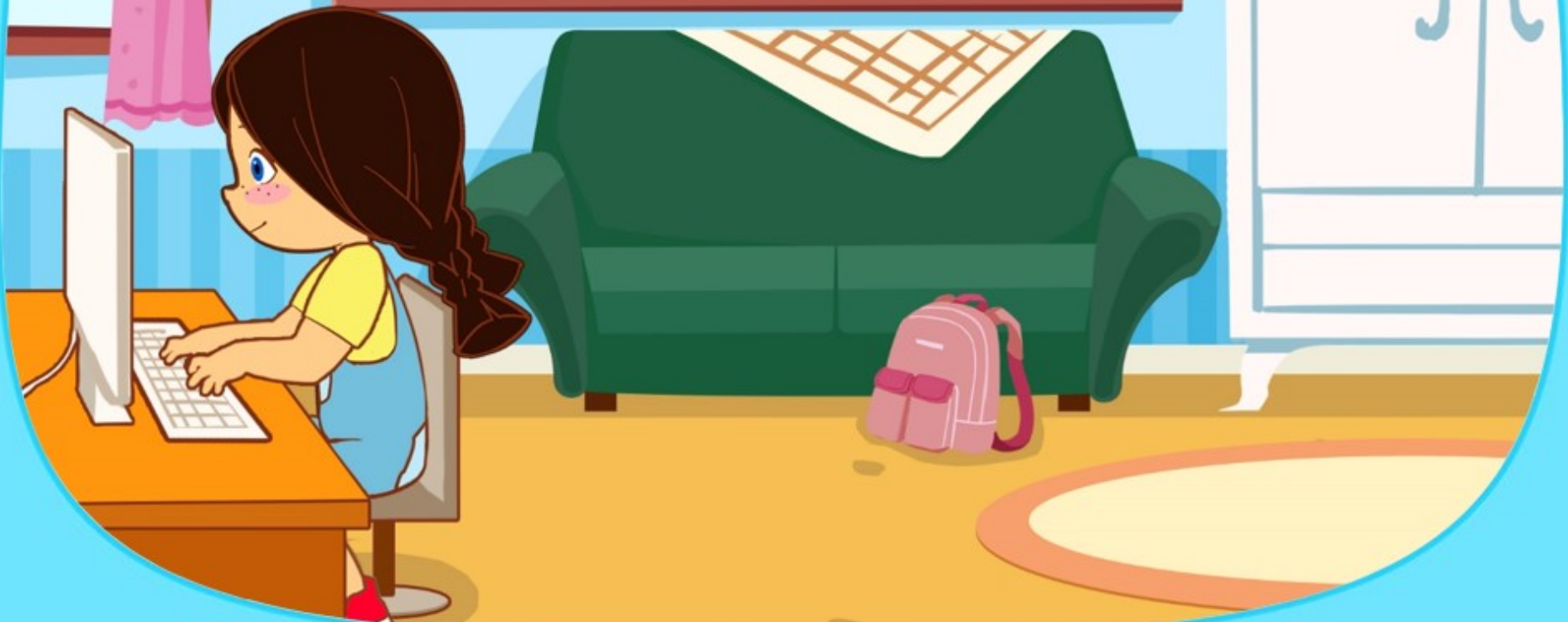
