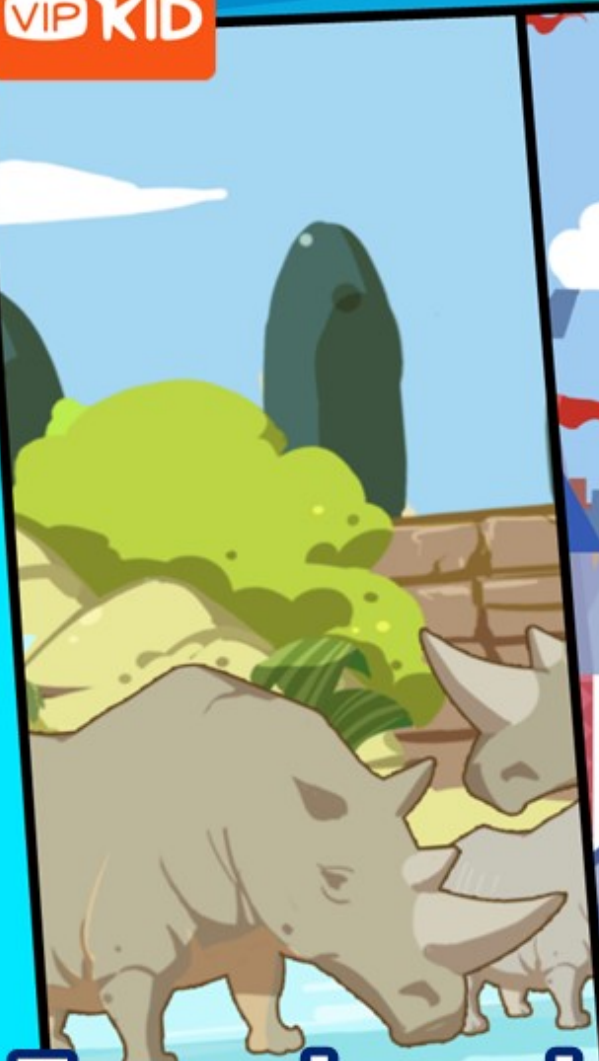

The Lee Family



Burger

burger - different kinds of meat, lettuce, and sometimes cheese between bread buns



The Lee family went to a restaurant at the airport and ate some **burgers**.

Board

board - to get on a plane, train, or ship



The Lee family **boarded** the plane with their small bags. A few people **boarded** without any bags.

Depart

depart - to move away from a place to another place



The plane took off and left the Beijing airport. It **departed** from Beijing.

Isolated

isolated - separated from others



When the Lee family arrived in the USA, they saw many small, **isolated** towns along the way.

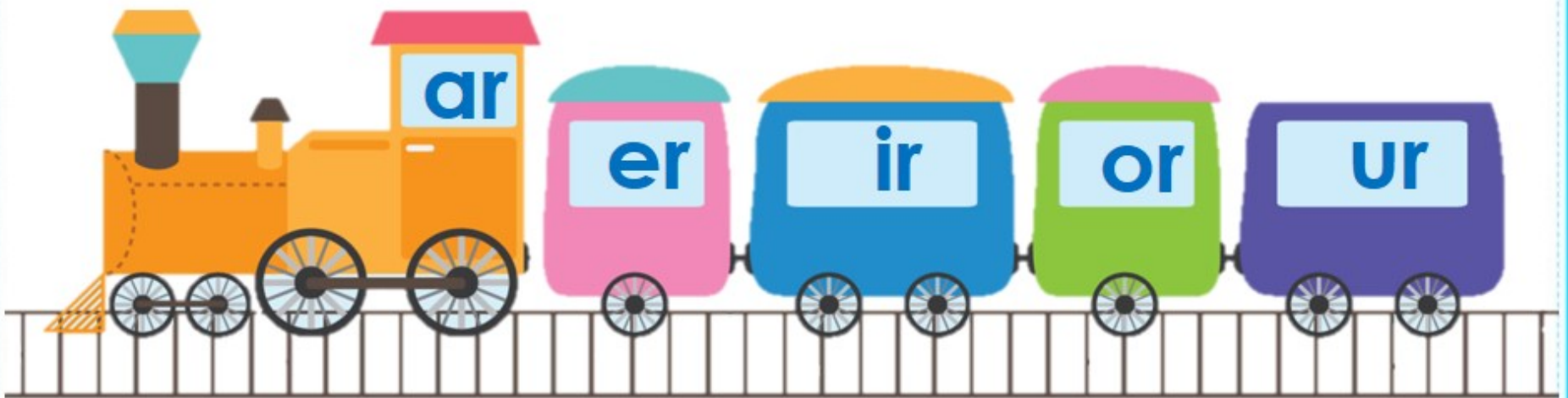

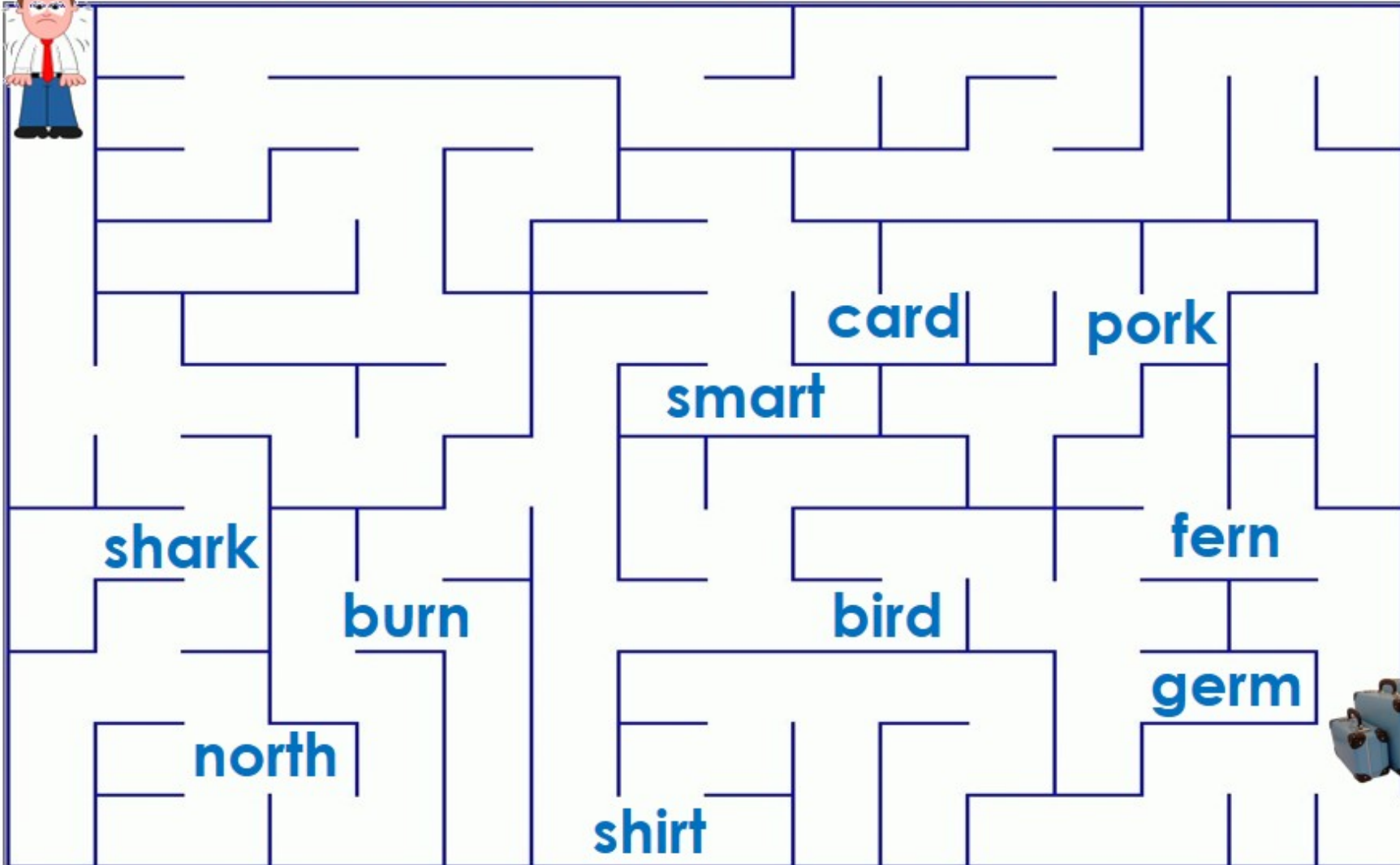

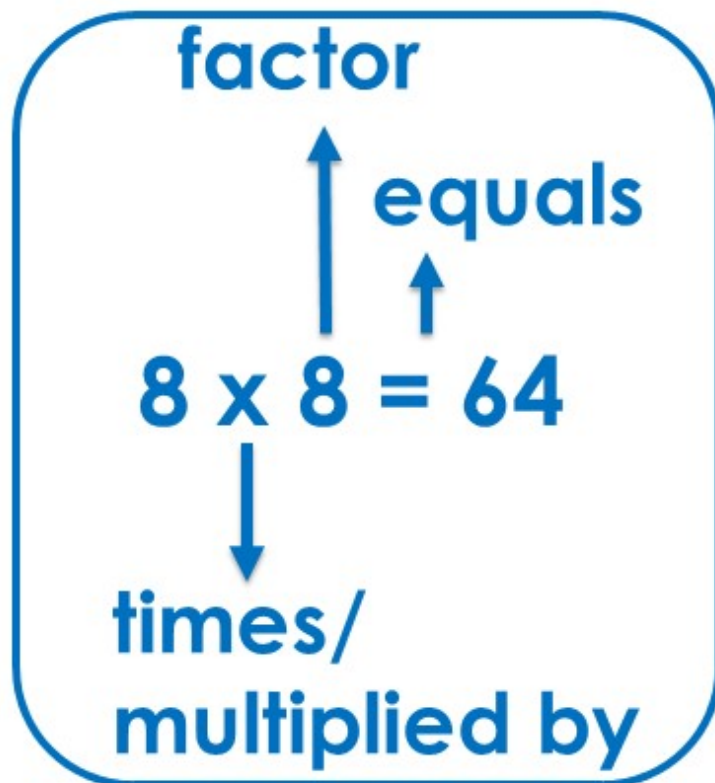

Multiplication



8 multiplied by 8
equals 64.

$$4 \times 4 = 16$$

$$4 \times 3 = 12$$

$$7 \times 2 = 14$$

Tips

We use “multiplication”
when we add a number to
itself once or more.

Division

24 \div 2 = 12

↑ equals

↓ divided by

24 divided by 2
equals 12.

$$\begin{array}{r} 10 \div 2 = 5 \\ 100 \div 10 = 10 \\ 8 \div 4 = 2 \\ _ \div _ = _ \end{array}$$

Word Problem

Tom needs \$300 to buy a ticket for a flight from Beijing to Shanghai. He has \$60. It's Monday morning now. The plane departs on Friday. How many dollars does Tom have to save a day?

$$\text{Step 1: } 300 - 60 = 240$$

$$\text{Step 2: } 240 \div 4 = 60$$



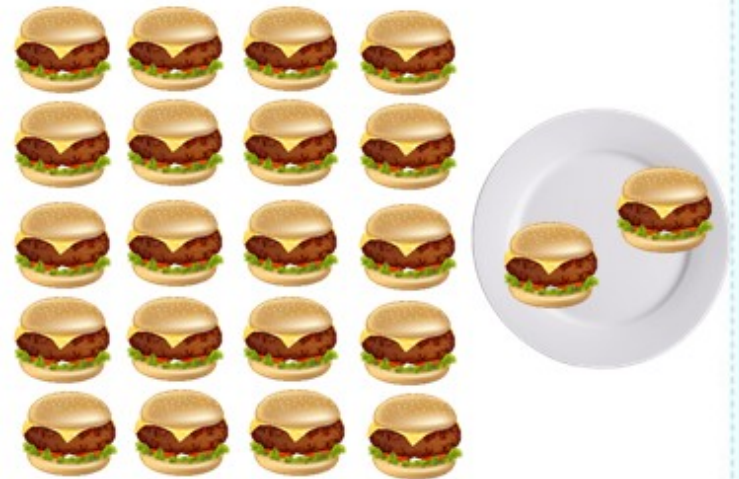
Tom has to save 60 dollars a day.
