

Weather can change fast!





The sun warms the land. It warms the air and water, too.


The sun's heat and light help things grow. Plants and animals need sunshine to live.




Sunny days are fun. You can play outside! Will you go to the park? Or ride a bike? The sun can make the air outside hot. You can cool off with a swim!













Drip, drop. Down comes the rain!

Water droplets in clouds sometimes fall as rain. Rain falls in warm and cool weather.

Rain helps plants and animals live. It fills rivers and ponds. Rain forms puddles on sidewalks. Splash!










Brrr! It's cold outside.

Water droplets in clouds
sometimes freeze. They can
fall as hail or snow.

If it's hail, you'll see ice. If it's snow, you might get a flurry (FLUR-ee). Often, a lot of snow means a snow day!



Lightning is a super-hot stream of electricity (ee-lek-TRIS-uh-tee). It lights up the sky. Flash! It zips from the cloud toward the ground.

After lightning comes a *BOOM!* That sound is thunder.

Hail is ice that rains from the sky. It can be small. Or it can be bigger than a baseball!

BLIZZARD: A heavy snowstorm with wind



Sometimes it doesn't rain for a long time. This is called a drought (drowt).



It's hard to see in a blizzard!

A hurricane brings heavy rain and strong winds.



Wind is moving air. A light wind is called a breeze. A strong wind is called a gale.

Wind has energy. It pushes clouds and rain across the sky. Wind can make kites dance.
