
The workmen picked up their tools. "Time to clear the line." They walked inside.






First, Henry was pushed out of the tunnel.




Then the trucks were pushed out.




At last, they saw what was in the tunnel.




It was an elephant! And he looked cross. He had run away from the circus.




The workmen fed him and gave him lots of water. The elephant felt better.




Henry felt better, too. He let off steam. Whoosh!




Henry's steam scared the elephant. Splash! Poor Henry.




It was time to go home. Everyone laughed at Henry.




"An elephant pushed me and splashed me," Henry grumbled.


