
A jet engine goes by pushing hot air out its back.




It is like a balloon full of air.




When you let it go, off it zooms.




Cranky does not look. His hook bumps the switch. Click!

Vroom! Vroom!






Thomas passes Percy. Whoosh!






Hi, Gordon! Vroom!




Bye, Gordon! Zoom!




At last, the jet engine runs out of fuel. Phew!




Thomas chuffs to the airport on his own steam! Peep! Peep!




Back at the Shed, Gordon ignores Thomas. Humph!


